## 2024 Family Camp Fees

Under one family account only a nuclear family of parents and their children can be registered. Other relatives and friends need to be registered under another account.

### Schedule of Deadlines

These deadlines are independent of which session of Camp you attend. If you pay by check, we expect the envelope to be postmarked by the deadline.

1. **May 31:** Pay by this deadline, because the fees rise the following day.
2. **June 30:**
  - Pay by this day if you missed the last one, because the fees rise again the next day.
  - This is the last day to let us know if you need to change weeks (for those already registered).

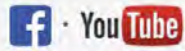
