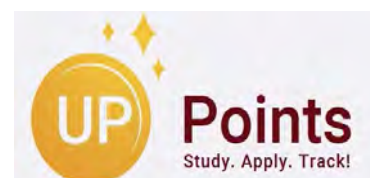
Leadership Coaching
