Hak Ja Han Moon donates \$1 million for quake relief

KATHMANDU (REPUBLICA): Universal Peace Federation (UPF) and Family Federation for World Peace and Unification (FFWPU) International Co-founder Hak Ja Han Moon has donated US\$ 1 million to Nepal to be used as relief for the victims of the April-25 earthquake.

According to a statement issued by Universal Peace Federation Nepal (UPF Nepal) on Sunday, half the amount — US\$ 500,000 will be given to the Prime Minister's Disaster Relief Fund while the other half will go to FFWPU-Nepal.

"These funds will be utilized to provide relief and recovery to the earthquake victims," Ek Nath Dhakal, chairman of UPF Nepal, was quoted as saying in the statement.
