Testimony 2: My testimony about True Mother

1. God's providence and his plans are the best.

My name is **Aishen Lee**. First of all I would like to express my gratefulness that I can be here today and give my testimony to you at this holy day (Day of all True Things). Some of the brothers and sisters already know about my experiences. I wanted to speak to you earlier, but I waited that God would show me the right moment. Last week when I was asked to give my testimony on the Day of all True Things, I felt that this was the situation God prepared for me to talk about my recent experiences.

2. God saved me and my family not only through True Father, but now also through True Mother.

Four years ago, on May 18, 2011 True Father came to Germany. My husband went to Germany and I stayed at home due to my physical condition. On the afternoon when True Father gave his speech in Berlin, I was cured from my sickness. After the event one brother told me that True Father mentioned that the families of those members who participated in his speech would be taken care of in a special way. I was very grateful to True Father for this. This experience motivated me one year later to go to Korea with my daughter to participate in True Father's Seong Hwa ceremony.

Last year in February my younger sister passed to spirit world very unexpectedly. This made me very depressed. Since last year July I was lying in bed, except from eating and

> taking care of myself in a very basic way. I didn't want to speak and I didn't want to meet anybody. I even avoided to speak with my mother who lives with us, and my husband and children. When I went to eat in the kitchen I was careful not to meet anybody. As we owe a Chinese restaurant, my husband took care of everything and he did all the work. When my children had holidays from school, they went to help in the restaurant. That's why they couldn't

participate in the HARP workshops. Only my youngest daughter could participate, due to the support of several blessed families. My heartfelt thank to all of them!

When True Mother visited Vienna on the 10th of May this year, which was at the same **day Mother's day**, I felt strength again to get up and participate . True Mother spoke in the Austria Center on the occasion of "50 Years Unification Movement in Europe". The event started with the Cheon II Guk Hymn. I could sing again, and I joined the hymn in Chinese language! While I was singing I felt strong support from the Spirit World. I felt relieved and all my burdens fell off my shoulders.

After the event I went for a walk near the Danube. I spent 4 hours there. Finally I wanted to make my way home, but then I felt like singing, so I sang Holy Songs in Chinese for one hour and arrived home at 8:00 pm.

I told my mother: "Please forgive me, mother! Forgive me that I was in bed for 10 months and that I caused you so much pain, suffering and sadnesss! Today is the day when I was cured, I regained my health!

I told my eldest daughter: "Julia, please forgive me that I didn't look after you for so long! You and your siblings must have had such a difficult time without the support of your mother!" She answered: "Mum, that's no probelm! We could learn a lot in these months!"

I am very grateful to God, True Parents and all the brothers and sisters for all the support, and I want to express my gratefulness in good deeds.

3. Health

After my long sickness I want to strenthen my body again. That's why I go to a park every morning to do Tai Chi exercises together with a group of people.

I realized that not only the spiritual body, but the physical body has to be fit as well. It is important not to neglect the physical body, because only if we are healthy we can help other people. Only in a healthy body can we fulfill our mission and work towards the fulfillment of Cheon II Guk.

Testimony 3: Newborn

My name is **Andi Egger.** The past few weeks have been very special to me. I had many experiences that turned my concepts upside down and made me realize all the blessings and chances that were given to me. In a way I feel as if I have been newborn, since I see things the way I never saw them before.

A few weeks ago Peter Zöhrer our national leader announced a 40 day Cheong Seong Condition in preparation for True Mother to come to in Europe. It should consist of at least 12 minutes of prayer each day and optionally other conditions as well. When I heard about it I made a commitment to follow it through since I wanted to make a personal preparation for our True Mother. However I didn't fully realize the importance of this event since I was in a time of personal struggles and still trying to find my own way within our movement.

At the beginning I found it hard to get into the spirit but after a while I noticed that these 12 minutes must be some kind of magical boundary that changes the atmosphere somehow.

I didn't experience this before but every time I started it took a few minutes until I got into it but after 12 minutes (I set the alarm clock) I felt it was most intense and didn't want to stop, so I continued for some minutes afterwards. But since I struggled with so many things the prayer almost turned in a spiritual fight and I wanted to know who is God, why is all of this so important and who are True Parents to me?

Of course I knew all of these things theoretically, I knew the principle of creation and restoration, and the course of history as described in the principle. But I never had experiences with God or True Parents, I just knew that my father has a strong foundation. Somehow I felt that this is the chance to experience it myself and to make it my own.

As the date of the event came closer I struggled to even decide to come since I felt I was completely missing the foundation to attend. However I had a few conversations with **D.** Zöhrer, a good friend of mine, and he finally convinced me to come.

I made the decision one week before, so there was still some

time left and I felt I should prepare for the event in some way. I heard that invitations for the concert of the Little Angels were handed out the rest of the week, however I didn't have time to participate. As I had taken some invitations already from the headquarters I thought why not doing it myself. So at Friday evening I went to some station nearby and started to hand out the leaflets for the concert of the Little Angels. It was a nice experience since people were receptive and interested to hear about a "Korean Folk Ballet" which is free of entry and includes beautiful coreographies they could enjoy.

Also I was glad as Elisabeth Cook phoned me and asked me if I could help to set up the stage for the concert, since I could contribute and felt more involved into the event. On Saturday morning we started and after two hours we were finished unloading everything and most people including myself were sent home. Nevertheless it turned out to be a good experience working together preparing for the event especially because the STF team was there.

I was really excited to see the Little Angels as I haven't seen them before. When the concert began I was really fascinated by the stories and beautiful dances and their incredible professionalism. You could feel the harmony of the dancers and it was amazing to see what passion these little kids conveyed in their performances. Also I loved when they started to sing, especially when they began to yodel. I couldn't believe that that was one of the best yodel I heard in my life. I found it really funny since that's what Austria is famous for, but hardly any Austrian has ever tried to yodel (me included).

The concert passed and I could really enjoy it wholeheartedly.

The next day the big event came and I was curious what to expect. I had given the chance to still participate in the organization by being the guard at the entrance. I did my best to fulfill this responsibility and got to know almost

the whole team involved in the organization, so I felt honored to be there.

The setup was exceptionally nice and even though I saw the hall before I was overwhelmed by the big crowd of people that attended this event. Since one of my relatives, Elisabeth Brandner was to be honored as a butterfly missionary she organized a table where my family and me could sit. I was very honored since I knew that only a smaller number of people had the chance to sit at a table in the back, so I could also experience the event in a different way.

Finally the program started and the music and presentations were very nice and gave a good atmosphere. I had to admit that I didn't know so much about the history of the unification movement in Europe, so the introductory videos were really interesting. I already knew the two speeches of True Mother that were shown, but I still could get some points out of it.

Then True Mother entered the hall and I could receive her wholeheartedly. Still I felt I was not as prepared as I should be, but I listened closely to the speech. I felt that the atmosphere changed and as if someone I knew for a long time but have not met for ages just came and spoke to me.

I felt good, but still in distance. It was the picture you see at events and speeches, True Mother standing on the stage but still far away, almost like in a dream. But just to experience her live even in distance was a special experience for me.

The awards ceremonies afterwards were also very beautiful and I could feel the incredible foundation we all stand on. I recognized that our parents and all of the first generation really did an incredible job in laying foundations so that we can be here today.

After the ceremonies were over and the Little Angels did a great performance again I had to leave soon to attend the Cranes Club.

I didn't really know what to expect, but was very curious about how it would turn out. After meeting some other 2nd generation there and some good introduction from Bogdan Pammer I already had a better idea about the purpose of that meeting which is to really connect as 2nd generation as professionals of our movement and to strengthen relationships beyond our local boundaries.

After an introduction by Dr. Kim True Mother entered the room. It which was much more personal than before. I never experienced her being physically so close to us as 2nd generation. She

was sitting right at the center of the room and even though I did not see her directly at this point, it was special for me.

I also loved the testimonies of the fellow 2nd generation members, there were many things to which I could relate, their experiences and struggles and how they go about pursuing their career and combine it with their believes. It was interesting to see how they actually managed to connect them, such that both aspects are able to coexist and make their lives more fulfilling.

After some great musical performances we saw the video of Hyo Jin, whom I didn't know so well. It surprised me since I have never heard of him in this way. He must have been very determined and a great leader, just as his father. I also understood why he is always referred to as the one filial son.

When True Mother started speaking, I really listened closely to grasp everything. Now it was real to me, the first time I can say I really experienced True Mother as a person, not just as a speaker somewhere far away to whom I could not really relate.

And I realized that what she said, she really meant it that way. I tried hard to digest it, and get out of it as much as I could. It was like the first time I could receive one of the messages of True Parents, because I felt it was real, and it really mattered to me.

The atmosphere became very personal, it started to feel as if True Mother was like a real grandmother to us. When she began to sing, that's when I could connect the most to her. Also, suddenly she stood at a position where I could directly see her. Before she never looked into my direction but suddenly she did and I felt as if she directly looked at me, also several times after. This way I felt a direct connection to

her so that it became even more real to me. This was really a precious time, because we were able to attend True Parents, so each of us also has a responsibility to fulfill.

This event ultimately changed my concept of True Parents, as it was the first time I felt a personal relationship towards them. So True Parents suddenly became real, from a picture on the desk to real people having dreams and hopes which they want to convey to us.

Suddenly I was not just an observer, but actively part of the providence at this time. I felt I wanted to contribute something and I too want to fulfill my role and connect with other 2nd generation. Even though I'm considered a Jacob's child it did not matter, I felt we were all at the same level.

The event finished with another few ideas of concrete projects which looked very promising. I was looking forward to stay connected and help developing the Cranes Club as an open platform for collaboration and support of 2nd gens. In any way I was glad to have attended this meeting!

The next morning I was lucky to attend the victory celebration with our True Mother. I already went there with a complete new determination and could feel the connection I built up the day before. I was standing at the back behind the last row of seats, so I could directly see True Mother as she was sitting there. Again I had the feeling she was looking at me, and I maybe felt a bit unworthy but proud to be there.

The celebration was very nice, with some musical performances and of course True Mother speaking. The musical performance from Sun Ji Nim and her husband was great and it also created a nice atmosphere. The most beautiful part was when True Mother

was singing Sarang Hae at the end. With all the people in the room it really felt as one family.

The next day we got the opportunity to officially say goodbye to our True Mother, as she was leaving the hotel in the morning. We were standing in the hallway in anticipation of True Mother leaving the hotel. After some time we realized she was already outside in the car, where we could say a last farewell before she left.

Now the weekend was officially over, and I felt really honored to have attended all these events. After True Mother left, some people were still standing in front of the hotel among which was Hoon Sook Nim, whom I did not really know before.

Even though I could not talk to her personally it was an honor meeting her and in the end I could personally say goodbye to her, which meant a lot to me. I felt the appreciation especially for the younger generation as she is part of the same generation.

For me the whole weekend has been very intense. It changed my mind and most of my concepts especially about True Parents and my own identity as part of our movement's young generation. I am still on my way to strengthen my faith.

I think it is a precious time that we live in and I am grateful that I could experience True Mother so closely. For me True Parents have become personally important and I want to take on the responsibility to fulfill my role as a member of our movement's young generation.
