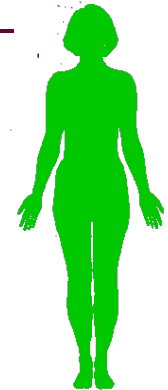

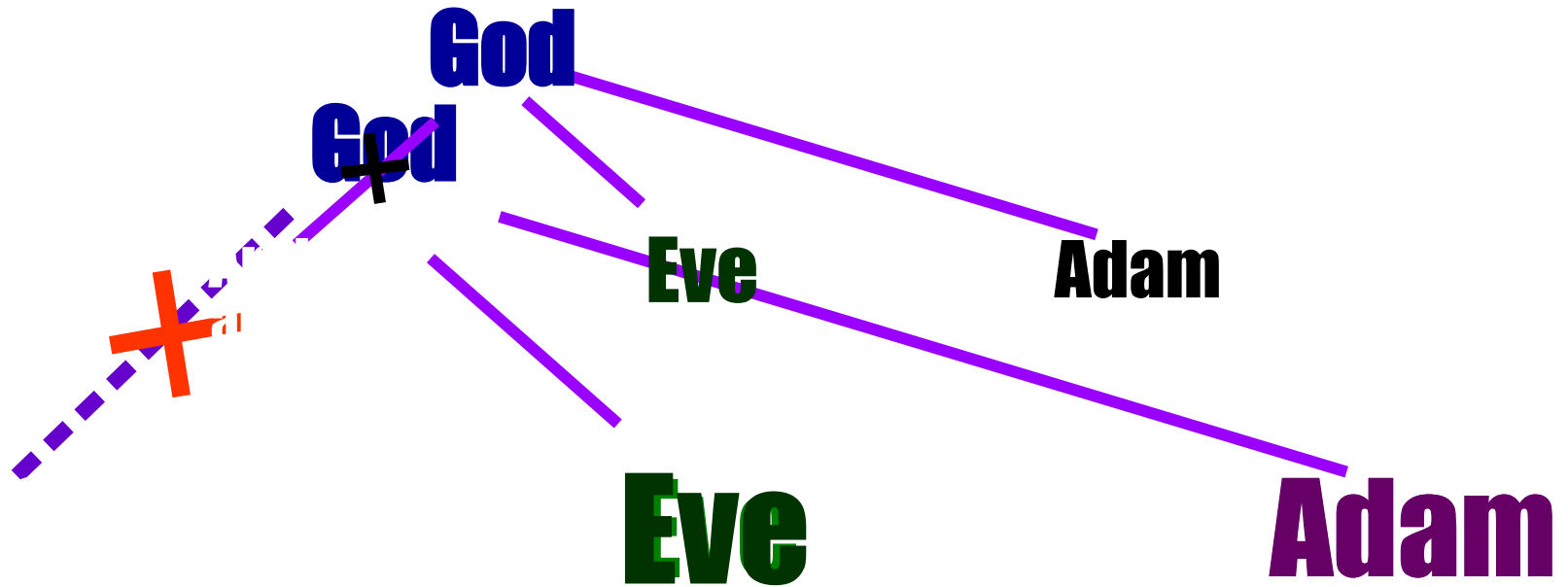

In recognizing reasons for homosexuality and the diversity of human experiences, it is vital to understand that love and acceptance are foundational to the healing process.

Emphasizing love for every individual, regardless of their sexual orientation, forms the basis for moving toward a more compassionate society.

The topic of homosexuality is complex and can be understood from various perspectives, including psychological, social, and spiritual dimensions.

Within my teachings, I have addressed the need for understanding and compassion towards individuals who identify as homosexual while also emphasizing the importance of God's ideal for love and sexuality.

1. *Understanding of Sexuality*: In my lecture at the "International Conference on the Unity of the Families" in 2008, I expressed, "Humanity is created in the image of God, yet the fallen nature leads to various expressions of sexuality that diverge from God's original purpose."

This acknowledgment highlights that various behaviors, including homosexuality, arise from the complexities of the fallen human condition.

2. *Role of Environment and Upbringing*:

From a psychological standpoint, factors influencing sexual orientation can include environmental conditions, upbringing, and personal experiences. I have addressed this indirectly by encouraging acceptance and understanding, noting during a speech at the "Youth Assembly for the Restoration of the Nation" in 1996, "We must strive to create environments of love and support, where young people can grow without fear and where they can accept themselves and each other."

3. ***Spiritual Struggle***: In discussing the paths to healing and restoration, I have pointed out the spiritual struggles individuals face due to fallen nature. In my talk at the "World Culture and Peace Conference" in 2001, I remarked, "Many individuals wrestle with their identity and struggle to align their lives with the ideals that God has set forth." This sense of struggle indicates the complexity involved in understanding one's sexuality in the context of spiritual growth.

4. *Call for Compassion*: Throughout my teachings, I have emphasized compassion for all individuals, recognizing their inherent worth as children of God. In my address at the "Global Peace Festival" in 2008, I stated, "The only way to truly understand and appreciate human life is to recognize the incredible value each individual possesses as a child of God."

This fundamental truth calls us to embrace one another with love and kindness, creating a world where the spirit of compassion flourishes.

In my discourses, I have addressed the issue of homosexuality, emphasizing that it diverges from the natural order established by God.

For instance, I have stated, "Homosexuality is unnatural, against God's law of creation" and "If the homosexual way of life became dominant, all mankind would be destroyed because it is totally contrary to nature" during my speeches.

In recognizing reasons for homosexuality and the diversity of human experiences, it is vital to understand that love and acceptance are foundational to the healing process. Emphasizing love for every individual, regardless of their sexual orientation, forms the basis for moving toward a more compassionate society.

6. *Education and Dialogue*: Encouraging open dialogue and education about sexuality, including homosexuality, is essential for fostering understanding. I have often said, “We must educate ourselves and each other, creating spaces for informative discussions that nurture understanding and compassion” (World Peace Conference, 1999).

This approach allows individuals to explore their feelings and experiences within a supportive framework, promoting personal growth and mutual respect.

7. *Encouragement of Spiritual Growth*: The focus of our teachings remains on each individual's responsibility to pursue spiritual growth, regardless of their orientation.

In my address during the "International Leadership Conference" in 2004, I emphasized, "Every person is on a journey of self-discovery and must seek to align with God's purpose for their life."

This highlights the call for spiritual awakening and personal reflection to navigate one's identity within the broader context of divine love.

8. *Importance of Unity*: Ultimately, the goal is to foster unity among all individuals, encouraging them to live in ways that contribute to collective healing.

As I remarked in my speech at the "Peace and Family Conference" in 2004, "Unity is built on understanding, and we are called to work hand in hand, supporting one another in our journeys."

The emphasis should be on building bridges of understanding that create a harmonious society, where people of all backgrounds come together in love and acceptance.
