Job Description for – Pastor of the Family Church of Alabama

The Pastor is responsible for conveying God’s word to the congregation, overseeing the spiritual well being of members, promoting church growth through outreach and witnessing, and encouraging service to and involvement in the local community.

- The Pastor serves as the spiritual leader and guide for the community members and will be responsible for the presentation and/or coordination of weekly Sunday Services.
- The Pastor strives to develop and raise awareness about the Blessing, Family Values, Divine Principle, and the need for Interfaith Cooperation through direct involvement in the local community.
- The Pastor will delegate leadership responsibilities to congregation member as is necessary for growth and development.
- The Pastor will inherit and develop working relationships with community and faith based organizations
- The Pastor will present plans for church growth and expansion
- The Pastor will adopt and implement programs designed to raise and empower young members and guests – particularly towards the Blessing
- The Pastor is responsible to attend monthly council meetings
- The Pastor is expected to perform Holy Day services, home visitation, weddings, death and funeral services, and to be involved with small groups.
- The Pastor will be supported by a communications liaison that will be responsible for communicating with national HQ, and the local council to implement national level HSA-UWC events locally.

Compensation

- At this time we are offering a salary of \$2300 monthly hopefully to be increased with additional grant funding and/or as our community grows.
