Young members who have been leading a model life of faith for at least 2 years

Young members proficient in at least one of the following languages: Korean, Japanese or English (Only Korean, Japanese, and English interpretation will be provided.)

Fees: True Parents' special grant will cover all workshop fees for international participants.

Program:

Education in True Parents' life courses

Special lectures and sessions on the arts and culture of heart (vocal training, dance, acting)

Musical performance for the celebration of True Parents' Centenary and 60th Holy Wedding Anniversary

Networking and cultural exchange among talented people in the arts and culture of heart
