A Global Rally for the Reunification of the Korean Peninsula, November 11, was held at Seoul World Cup Stadium.

The Rally was attended by over 60,000 people. Included in the list was James Woolsey, CIA director 1995, expressed his support and hundreds of religious leaders were present. Included in the lineup were prominent figures from Christianity, Buddhism, Islam, Judaism, Hinduism, Confucianism, Sikhism, Shintoism, Jainism and Bahá'ism.

Many are already deeply committed to the Inter-religious Leadership Conference and one Buddhist group has signed up for more with express interest in the Principle. Their branches in different countries are listening to FFWPU representatives this week.
