

WFWP Ukraine Organizes Project to Help Vulnerable Displaced Families

In frames of social protection and support of vulnerable groups in Ukraine, WFPW-Ukraine has been taking care of the internally displaced families, people who were in the ATO and people with special needs.

Together with our long-time partner, Humanitarian HQ of the NGO "All-Ukrainian Organization for Internally Displaced People", we helped solve the financial issue of renting an apartment for the Ageev family, internally displaced family with four sons. They were also one of the first included in our humanitarian aid program. There are four boys in the family who constantly need clothes and shoes.

Material targeted aid was provided to three more families who are either IDPs, either have children with special needs.

In addition, Women's Federation sent women for free ultrasound, with the support of Kyiv City Council deputy Konstantin Yalovy. They also received clothing and food kits as a humanitarian aid.

To help families affected by the anti-terrorist operation in the Eastern Ukraine, WFPW provided support to Lyudmila Zhdan, the widow of an anti-terrorist operation participant. She now raises two grandchildren left without parents. Project coordinator Natalia Ilyina met with Lyudmila and provided assistance to children. The woman was invited to our events and trainings.

There was also a meeting with volunteer Milanika. A single woman volunteered for 3 years in the anti-terrorist operation, and at the moment she is under treatment at a military hospital in Kyiv Oblast. We provided material assistance, involved Milanika in psychological trainings, our integration programs and other activities.
