First of all, I would like to thank Heavenly Parent and True Parents for giving me this opportunity to speak. Hello, my name is Moon-min Kang, and I came from Korea as part of the 5th Heavenly USA Overseas Service Team. Today, I would like to share a few things I felt while witnessing on Fremont Street.

Through witnessing activities, I was able to realize many things. In particular, it became a time for me to confront the fallen nature within myself. Through this experience, I came to understand more clearly what kind of person Heavenly Parent and True Parents desire me to become.

After arriving in America, I had two goals.

The first was to do the things that no one else wanted to do before anyone else did. I believed that the things I disliked doing were probably the same things others disliked as well, so during this period, I resolved to take responsibility for the tasks everyone tended to avoid, and I tried to practice this every day.

The second was to offer all the devotion and sincerity that I possibly could. I did not want to waste any spare time, and since I felt that these 85 days were not long at all, I wanted to invest myself completely. Because of this, I tried to live each day without losing my sense of urgency.

However, as I continued living this way every day, I eventually discovered that I had unconsciously begun to feel that all of my efforts, devotion, and lifestyle were “my own.” I realized that at the root of all my motivations was myself. The reason I came here to Las Vegas should never have become about “me,” yet before I knew it, I was living for myself and offering devotion for my own sake.

As a result, I found myself hoping that the devotion I offered would bring results to me personally. Because of this, when I saw other team members receive membership forms and gain spiritual children, I realized that I could not fully congratulate them from my heart. From Heavenly Parent’s perspective, these should have been moments of great joy, and I should have been grateful to the team members who laid the conditions for victory and offered reports of success. But seeing that I could not do that made me deeply dislike myself.

At that moment, I even began to doubt the efforts and devotion I had offered up until then. But afterward, one of our captain’s witnessing contacts decided to fill out a membership form, and watching that process led me to deep reflection. I had seen from nearby how much devotion had been invested, how firmly he maintained their center, and how they guided the person until the very end. Seeing this allowed me to face my own shortcomings even more clearly.

At the same time, I came to trust Cheonshim Won devotion even more deeply. Centering on Cheonshim Won, Heavenly Parent, and True Parents, I realized that if we offer devotion sincerely, Heaven will absolutely work. I also learned that it is possible to sincerely celebrate someone else’s victory with all my heart.

Since that day, I began offering the same prayer every day:

This time, I sincerely wanted to congratulate everyone wholeheartedly. Yet once again, I found myself becoming discouraged, and I struggled because I hated seeing that side of myself.

So at Cheonshim Won, I honestly reported all of these emotions to Heavenly Parent. I earnestly prayed about how I should spend the little time remaining in this period and how I could overcome these feelings.

At that moment, one thought came strongly into my heart: “I will do my absolute best in the things that I can do.” I came to realize that Heavenly Parent desires me to find the work that only I can do and to carry it out with Heavenly Parent alone at the center.

Therefore, just as Heavenly Parent is the same from beginning to end, I also want to resemble Heavenly Parent by keeping my original heart and determination until the very end, continuing both my devotion and my actions without wavering. From the moment I open my eyes until the moment I close them, I will strive to live each day not for myself, but with Heavenly Parent as the sole motivation behind everything.
