

2-week Mission to Bolivia, the country of mission as a Japanese missionary in 1996-7

Practice DP and substantialize the mission of Tribal Messiah

On June 18th, at 5 am, my 21-year old daughter Nathalie and I arrived in La Paz, Bolivia, at 4000 m height, with a feeling of coming back home. 16 years before, True Father sent me there as part of the 4200 Japanese missionaries to the Americas, 120 per country, leaving behind husband and children.

Diana and Carlos were at the airport, waiting for us. They brought us to their home situated in a suburb 40 minutes away and a few hundred meters lower. On that same first day, we met 4 of the people who had come to know our movement in 1996-7 through our activities and had kept in contact with me.

UPF and Arts Presentations

From the beginning, our spiritual children organized opportunities to present UPF's universal principles for peace at various places, like a health shop or a friend's house. We participated in many different formal and informal gatherings at which people came to know UPF and our TP.

Nathalie supported each time by inspiring people through arts. She can open people's hearts through her songs and dances and represents a model for the youth.

Family Federation centre

We met the national leader, Nely Almanza, who is managing the house that had been bought 16 years before for our mission. Their family with 2 and 4-year old daughters and another blessed couple family share the house with a dozen intern youths who spend their time between raising funds, giving testimony and helping in various activities. It was like going back not 16 but 30 years, when so many of us were going through this same course. Some of them were blessed but hadn't started family yet. Others had been sent out to pioneer more cities. It was like watching True Mother's dream come true.

Reaching out activities

The Youth Federation office is just in front of the University. Every day, the office is attended from morning to evening and the witnessing team brings guests to the office to give them an introduction, read DP with them or show them a DVD. Nathalie gave a few music and movement classes to young children as part of her bachelor's thesis. It was simultaneously a great opportunity to meet teachers, exchange knowledge on pedagogy and leave behind e-mail addresses as well as invitations to different events.

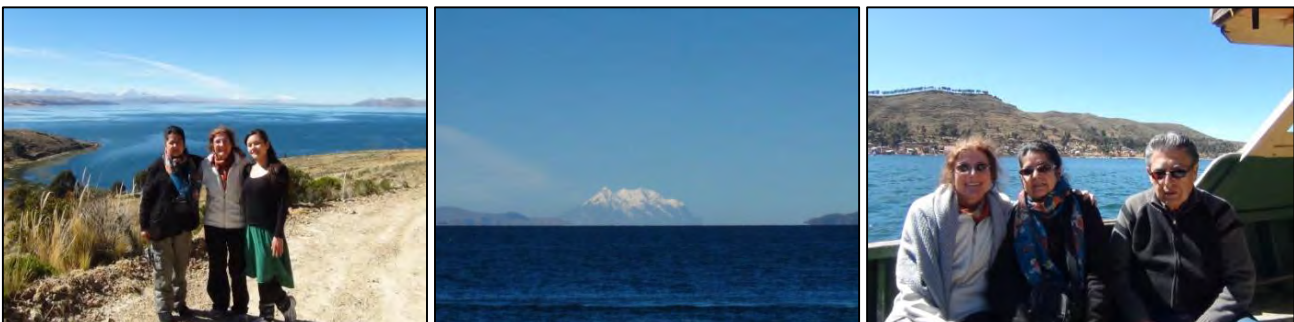

We also created events at a Tribal Messiah's home and, thanks to new participants who showed interest and wanted us to be part of their events, the activities multiplied during our stay. Great synergy was generated on all sides.

Internal struggle

One problem we observed was the difficulty of older membership to align with the new leadership and the youth. The very strong feelings of not being listened to and appreciated led some members to separate and do their own activities and to look for support and understanding in different countries, even as far as asking the US blessed family department to arrange a blessing the Bolivian leadership didn't approve of. We felt sorry for not being able to contribute to the harmonization of that situation. Of course, we know this situation exists throughout the world, at all levels, and requires restoration of fallen nature on all sides.

At the 2 Sunday services, I was able to share about the mission of the Japanese missionaries. A few of the people who had joined in 1996-7 were present. We felt so much gratitude. I could see that the year spent there by the 120 had not been in vain and had indeed brought some substantial fruit for the Providence.

Looking at the result 16 years later made me feel sorry because so many of the great people we had met had gone and at the same time happy because a few had remained and devoted their lives to build CIG in their country. Also, as it had allowed our family to sacrifice and practice living for the sake of others, God could bless us abundantly as a result without giving Satan a basis for accusation.

This time, we received much more recognition and support than we had dreamt of. Our 2 ½-week stay allowed us to meet our spiritual children, take care of them in some way, and accumulate an amazing amount of vitality elements to continue our Tribal Messiah mission in our own country, Switzerland.

This kind of "vacation" doing foreign mission is like filling both the country you visit and yourself with the most precious holy spirit energy. You find yourself in different situations and, dealing with them centered on God and TP, you pray that it contributes to the Providence.
