Message from the Founders

This year marks a historic moment for High Noon as we celebrated the landmark of ten years of serving our blessed family community.

Ten years ago, we sounded the alarm that internet pornography was devastating an entire generation of young people. At the time, few recognized the depth of the problem, and those who did were often ill-equipped to address it or to help young people find freedom from harmful habits. We began by educating leaders, then youth. Soon after, we expanded our efforts to couples—not only warning about the dangers of porn and masturbation, but also teaching the ideal of Absolute Sex as articulated in True Parents' teachings. Along the way, we discovered a crucial truth: the most effective way to help young people overcome self-centered habits is to help them form a vision for sexuality in their own lives.

Over the past decade, High Noon has evolved in powerful ways. Leaders and members, parents and children, singles and blessed couples have all arrived at the same conclusion: healthy conversations about sex are the most effective safeguard against unhealthy and destructive habits.

High Noon became international almost immediately. In our second year, we educated 1,300 young people at Global Top Gun. When they returned to their home nations, they spoke with their leaders and opened pathways for High Noon to be invited into their communities—educating them about Absolute Sex and helping to establish cultures of honesty, grace, integrity, accountability, and courage. Today, we have five chapters around the world and have just completed our "10-Year Anniversary Global Tour", visiting all five continents.

High Noon's goal is to change the world through sex. The teaching of Absolute Sex was a cornerstone of True Father's ministry, and it remains central to ours.

Although we are usually focused on what lies ahead, this milestone gives us a rare opportunity to pause and reflect on how far we've come. We are building the Pure Love Movement that True Father instructed us to begin. Over the past ten years, we have heard thousands of testimonies from young people and couples whose lives have been transformed through our events and programs. Beyond that, we have also received testimonies from individuals whose lives were touched by someone who attended a High Noon program reaching out to them.

High Noon is ministering to a real and universal need. We all long for sexual intimacy and love with our spouse or future spouse. At the same time, we all face challenges to live in full alignment with our values around sex. God does not expect perfection. High Noon acknowledges the real struggles of our members and chooses not to ignore them. In doing so, we create space for healing, forgiveness, and renewed hope—even where mistakes have been made. This reflects the deepest wish of our Heavenly Parent: to forgive and to grant another chance for happiness.

At this landmark moment in High Noon's history, I want to acknowledge everyone who has encouraged us—and everyone who has had the courage to work on themselves, to grow in sexual integrity, and to draw closer to God's standard of Absolute Sex. With gratitude, hope, and conviction, we look ahead to the next ten years. We will undoubtedly face even greater challenges, but I believe we will not only meet them—we will see ourselves and our young people grow ever closer to becoming divine sons and daughters of our Heavenly Parent, and blessed couples who radiate God's love.

High Noon World Tour 2025



One of the year's key highlights was High Noon's 10-Year Anniversary World Tour. The tour **launched on May 17 in the Philippines**, continued with events in **Japan, the United States, Czechia, and Brazil**, and concluded in **Bolivia on June 28**.

The tour events consisted of two-day workshops in which participants were guided to confront personal struggles with courage and to envision a life rooted in integrity, unconditional love, and purpose.

With **967 participants** worldwide, the High Noon World Tour fostered deep transformation and meaningful connections across the globe.

The documentary highlights the past ten years of High Noon's work and mission — capturing how a single calling grew into a global movement dedicated to turning shadows into light.



Through a blend of footage, testimonies, and moments from around the world, the documentary reflects on the impact of High Noon's programs, the connections formed across continents, and the transformations experienced by individuals and communities over the past decade.



It also showcases the 10-Year Anniversary World Tour, offering viewers an inside look at the workshops and experiences that made this milestone celebration so meaningful.

Africa Tour

This year, **High Noon reached Africa for the first time** in its decade-long journey, hosting **five-day workshops in four countries: Benin, Zambia, the Democratic Republic of the Congo, and Ivory Coast**, with a total of **107 participants**.



Four High Noon staff members — Andi, Sammy, Seiji, and Andranik — led the workshops, offering many participants their first experience of High Noon culture and the importance of sexual integrity.



The Africa Tour had a profound impact, inspiring participants to continue learning and engaging with High Noon's teachings. The tour also opened new doors for High Noon in the continent, leaving the team with both hope and valuable insights for future initiatives.

The five-day High Noon workshop was truly an experience filled with deep knowledge, personal growth, fun, and emotional activities. During the workshop, **my entire perspective about sex, purity, and the Blessing completely changed.** I learned many important values, such as how to keep my purity, how to take responsibility for my mistakes, and the realization that my sexual organs are the palace where God dwells, so I must protect my sexual integrity.

Among all the activities, my favorite was the Radar activity. Through it, **I felt a strong sense of comfort knowing that I am not alone—that there are others who go through similar struggles, and together we can support one another.** The highlight of the workshop was the 'Lifting Shame' activity, where I opened up about my past struggles with sexual integrity in high school. It was a very emotional and freeing experience for me. I felt so relieved to finally let go of the feelings I had been holding inside for so long.

Although I feel a bit sad that the High Noon team will soon be leaving Benin, their teachings will always remain in my heart. I am truly grateful for the opportunity to have been part of this workshop. **This experience has truly been a turning point in my life.**

I learned that even if I have wounds from my past, they do not define my future. I learned that my past is my past — but it is not my life. I learned that my value does not depend on my weaknesses, my appearance, or what people say about me.

They taught me that I am a daughter of God, that **God loves me and knows me, and that I can heal from my past, from my fears, and from my negative thoughts.** One thing that really touched me was when they told me I could put a full stop to my past — to stop feeling weak and start becoming strong, taking care of myself.

Thanks to the High Noon program, **I understood that I can rise up again.** I understood that I must always listen to the voice of God in my heart. I understood that even though I am wounded, God wants to use me to heal others, and that I should no longer fear sharing my testimony. I learned to face my fears and realize that I am not alone. Thanks to this teaching, **I began to value myself, respect myself, and speak about what I feel in front of others without shame and with courage.** I understood that I need to change to become a better person.

I feel understood and seen.** I realized that I'm not alone and there are people out there who understand my pain and who want to see me and every struggling person heal. I think this experience was really great. Yes, I'm anxious, but I'm really happy and looking forward to opening up, letting go, and healing.

I think all youths should participate in a High Noon workshop. Whether you were hurt or not, High Noon will help us grow our hearts for our family and friends, for the people we will meet in the future, and especially for our children.



Total Unique Participants*

A total of **856 unique participants*** engaged in High Noon's online programs this year, representing a truly global community.



Under 20




20s - 30s


Online Programs Participation by Chapter

High Noon currently operates **five international chapters in addition to North America**, each led by **dedicated chapter leaders: Latin America, Europe, Japan, the Philippines, and Korea.**

Chapter Program Highlights:

"Radiant" Launched in Japanese



This year, the *Radiant: Intimacy for Couples* program was launched in Japanese for the first time.

A total of 25 Japanese-speaking participants took part and reported a highly positive impact on their relationships with their spouses.

Korea Chapter Launched

The Korea chapter was officially launched in the last quarter of the year, led by the new chapter leader, Soobin Lee.



As its inaugural program, the chapter hosted a *Wives' Group*, welcoming a total of five participants. All participants reported a meaningful and positive experience, both within the group and in their relationships with their partners.

At first, I thought I could overcome my struggles on my own, but reflecting on my past made me realize how much pornography had disrupted my life. Joining Ascend reminded me that I'm not alone in this journey.

*In the beginning, I shared as much as I could about my past in group calls and daily reports to my mentor. **As I opened up, my urges for pornography decreased, and I became more aware that I am loved and forgiven.***

Through the program, I also learned the importance of sharing my feelings with my wife rather than just managing on my own. Practicing this in group work helped deepen our connection. I even gained confidence in guiding my child, believing that if I can overcome challenges, my child can too.

*What I value most is **learning that our worth doesn't depend on mistakes or struggles.***
