Dr. Lek tribal group held Tribal Messiah Blessing in Buriram province from 6-14 July for 4 blessing in 4 districts of Buriram province. This comes from determination to restore 6 tribes for restoration of 430 families by coming 3rd year Seonghwa memorial of True Father.

Also, FFWPU Thailand will do her best also to restore 12 tribes restoration of 430 families by coming 3rd year Seong Hwa anniversary. So, since March 2015, Many Tribal leaders and Blessed Families are uniting to hold many Blessing ceremony, witness to John Baptist figures – government leaders, Divine Principle Education, follow up for 40 days separation and 3 days ceremony and education of Blessed Family Tradition and raise up new tribal leaders.
