As part of Rev. Moon's Centennial Exhibition, which ran from October 19 to November 1, several Forums were organized by the various Federations founded by Rev. Moon and his wife Hak Ja Han Moon.

On October 31, WFWP held its Forum on the theme, "Women's Dignity and Women's Leadership." It should have taken place at Espace Barrault in Paris, however, due to the reconfinement it was held by Zoom. This allowed us to have many more participants!

Brigitte Wada, President of WFWP France, introduced the event by presenting the various forums in pictures. Then she went on to introduce WFWP and the theme of the meeting.

The first speaker was Ms. Hélène Pichon, administrator of the INTERNATIONAL WOMEN'S FORUM and author of the book "The Eternal Feminine." She told of the difficulty of being a spiritual leader, when you are a woman, and how to restore the feminine to its rightful place. A rich and exciting intervention.

The second speaker was Jennifer Lambert, member of WFWP in Poitou Charentes. She advocated respect for human rights. With a Power Point, she addressed the subject of gender theory and its impact on women's dignity.

Finally, the third speaker was Sabine Le Blanc, Professor of General Culture and Communication in Higher Education and author of "The Birth of a New Humanity." She hypothesized that part of the story would have corresponded to a true genocide of the feminine. A bold, though well-documented and well-

treated look.

After the three speakers finished, there was a question/answer time. We concluded this rich and inspiring meeting with a song "Hand in Hand" performed very movingly by a young woman, while the many social interventions of WFWP took place in pictures from around the world.
