COURSES OFFERED

1. Bachelor of Philosophy Program

The undergraduate course in philosophy is a semestral course toward a straight bachelor degree in Philosophy directed to prepare a high school graduate into a service oriented career life development. The course is so designed to render students of various religious denominations a wholistic knowledge and appreciation of life orienting him into the different academic activities utilizing the fundamental knowledge that would enhance life and human nature. 2. Bachelor in Secondary Education—Major in Values Education

The Secondary Education Program seeks to prepare teachers as school leaders committed to youth, scholarship and lifelong learning through a scholar-practitioner learning community characterized by a learner-centered curriculum, field experience, mentoring, and practical inquiry.

3. Bachelor of Arts in Political Science

This program focuses on a critical understanding of the public and private institutions, structures and processes of 'governance'. The program embraces a range of forms of governance. The program gives a good grasp of how important decisions are made in today's society – at the international, national, provincial and local level – by both governmental and non-governmental organizations. Students will learn how social, environmental, economic, and political and justice issues are accommodated in the Philippines and on a global scale. It will discuss the value of 'good governance' – what it means, and how social justice, democracy, citizenship and human rights fit – or not – into the equation and learn about how issues of social welfare, immigration, social and criminal justice have made the tasks of governance more complex. Furthermore, it will explore how governments have increasingly turned to the private and non-profit/voluntary sectors to deliver services formerly undertaken by governments directly.

4. Bachelor of Arts in Journalism

The Bachelor of Journalism program encourages the students to develop their own vision of journalism by drawing on our vast collective experience of journalism practice and our research into journalism and communication.

Students are required to meet many different kinds of people and to travel. The basis of journalism is Discovering, Collecting, Assembling, Analyzing and Presenting Information. To do this effectively, we require students to have highly developed skills in language, a good understanding of the media, an interest in current affairs and a broad general knowledge.

5. Bachelor in Business Administration Major in Marketing/ Human Resource Development Management

The Management program strives to raise the level of academic work in the field of marketing and human resource in methodological rigor, conceptual depth, and managerial applicability. Management program prepares students for a variety of career paths within established organizations, in new, high-growth/high-potential ventures, and in professional areas that service such ventures (including venture capital, investment banking, consulting, corporate venturing, etc.). This is to prepare students for leadership positions in these areas.

6. Bachelor of Science in Entrepreneurship

The Entrepreneurship program gears towards helping the students in venturing small scale and large scale business enterprise. The most obvious form of entrepreneurship is that of starting new businesses that may include social and political forms of entrepreneurial activity. When entrepreneurship is describing activities within a firm or large organization it is referred to as intra-preneurship and may include corporate venturing, when large entities spin-off organizations.
