# Two New Acting National Leaders



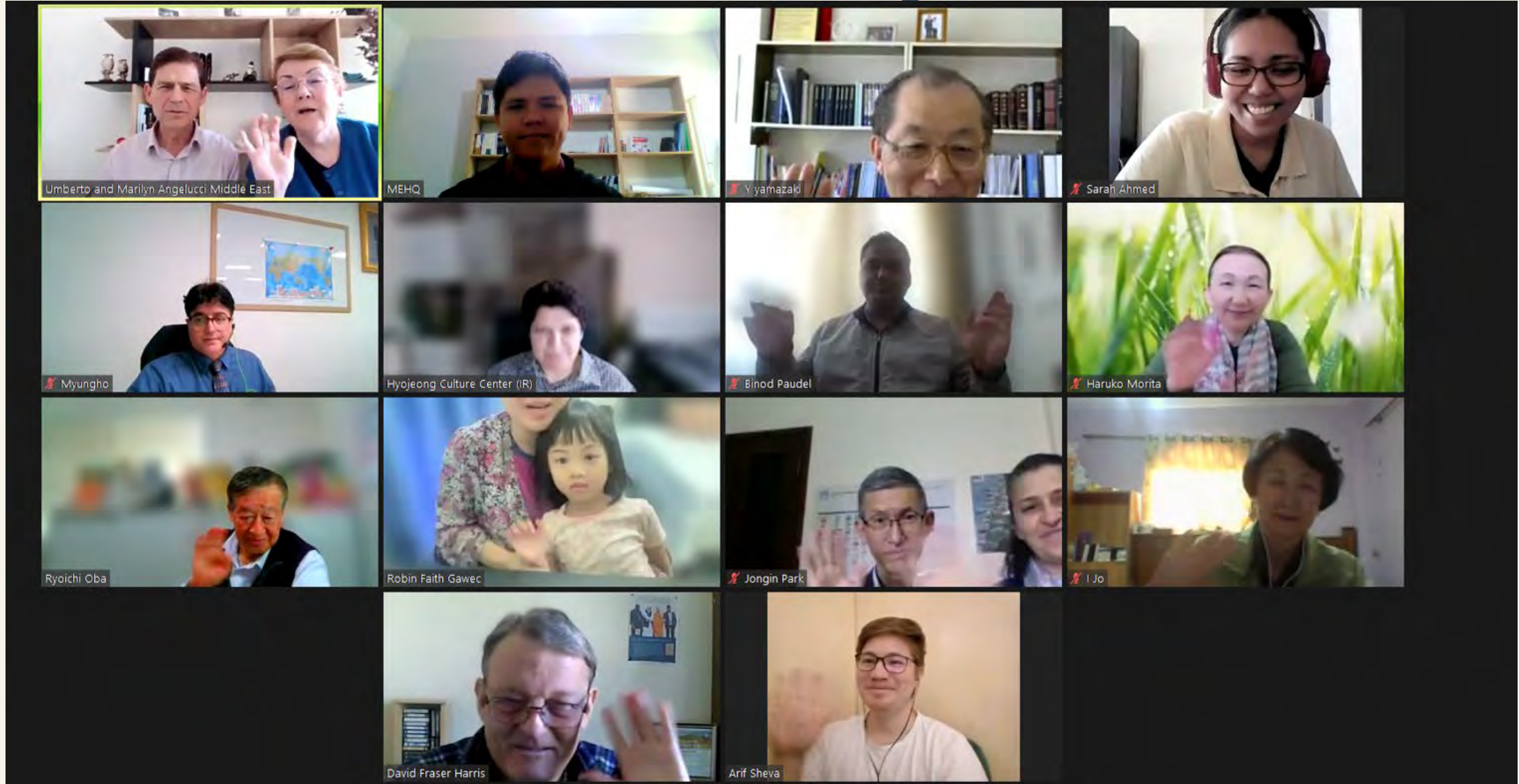

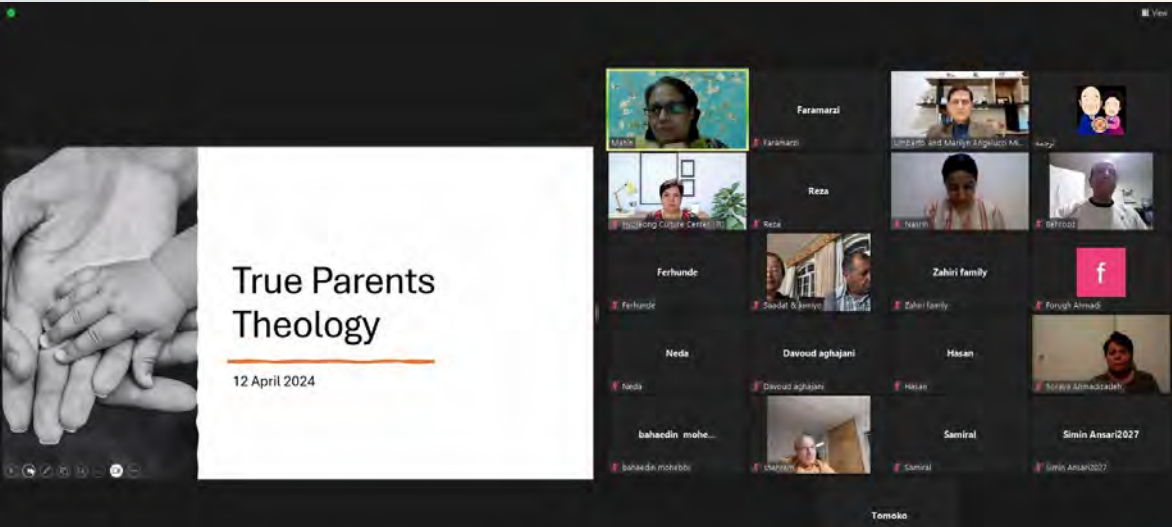

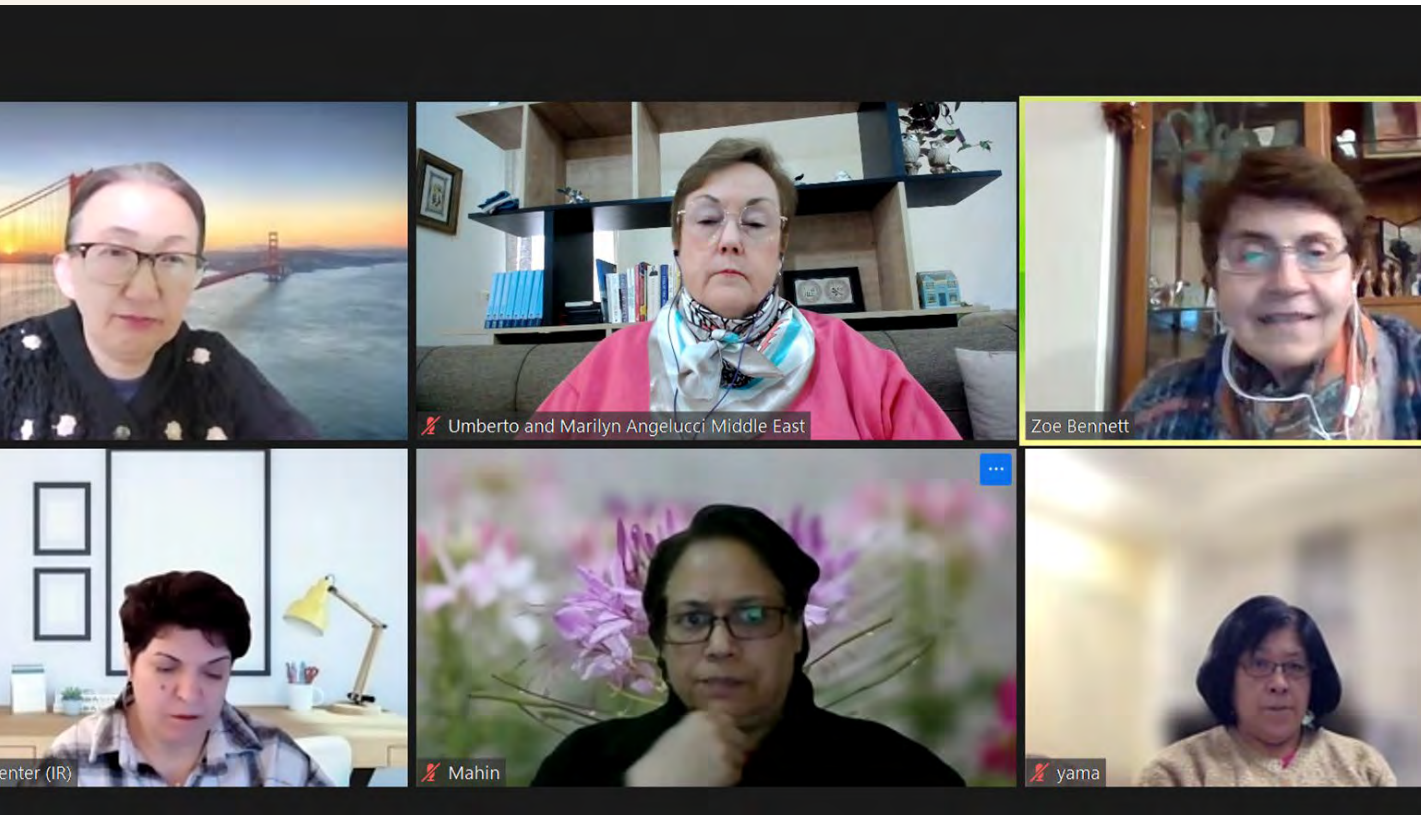


# Studying True Parents Theology in the Era of CIG

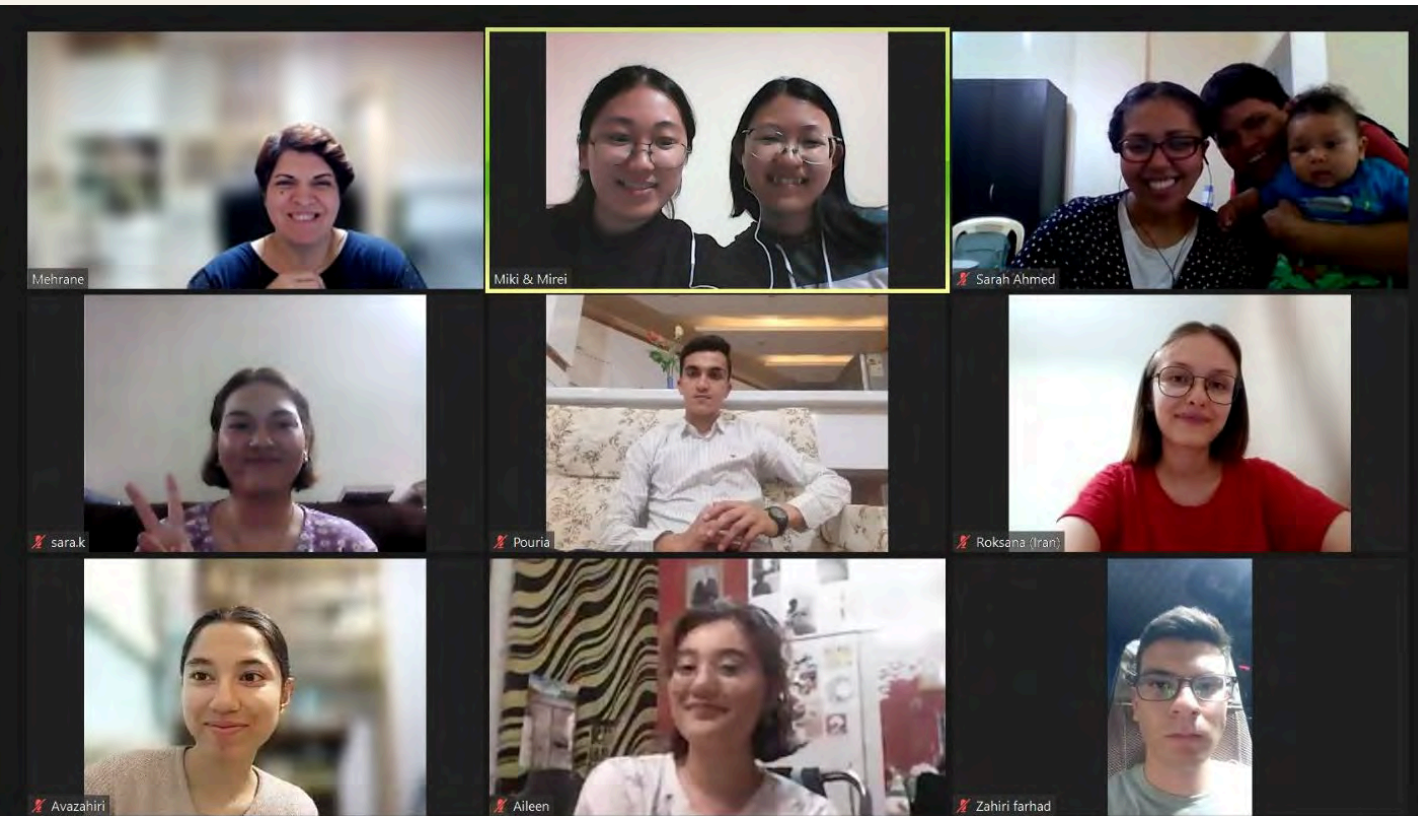
