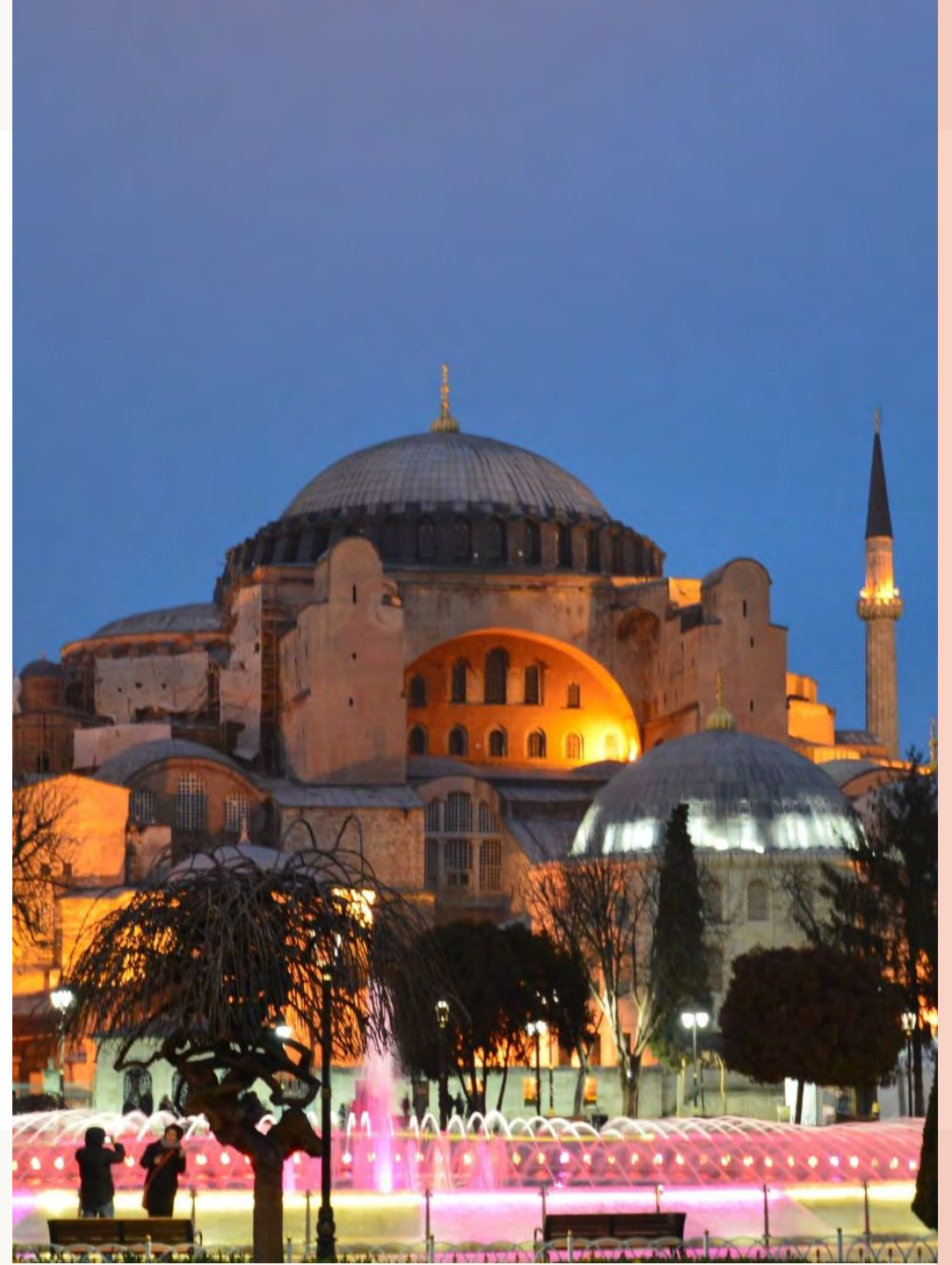
From Lebanon, 8 members are expected to go, but most of them are waiting for their visas.

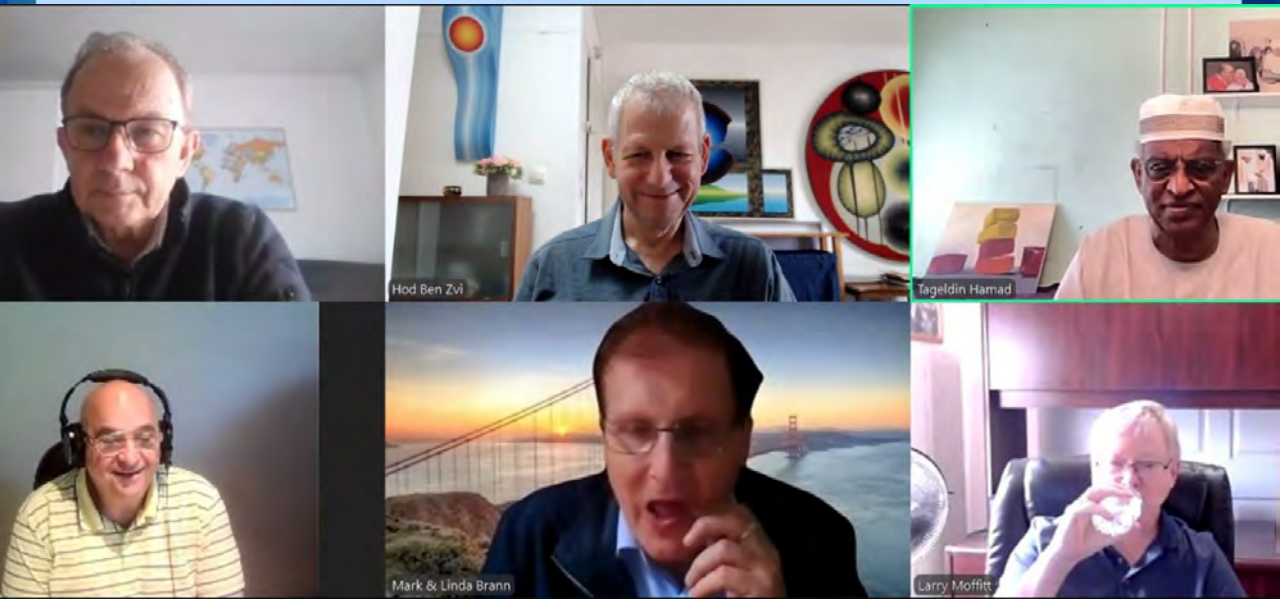
Preparing the Environment for Witnessing



UPF Middle East Webinar: Middle East Conflicts



UPF Israel collaborated with the Washington Times Foundation to host a webinar on Middle East conflicts. Dr. Haim Koren, an Israeli diplomat and former Ambassador to Egypt and South Sudan, provided a comprehensive overview of the region’s key actors from a geopolitical perspective. The conversation explored the Middle East within the context of conflicting interests in Europe and the Indo-Pacific. Dr. Michael Jenkins, President of The Washington Times Foundation, concluded by emphasizing the importance of seeking new paths to peace despite the challenging circumstances.



UPF Turkey: Peace Road 2024

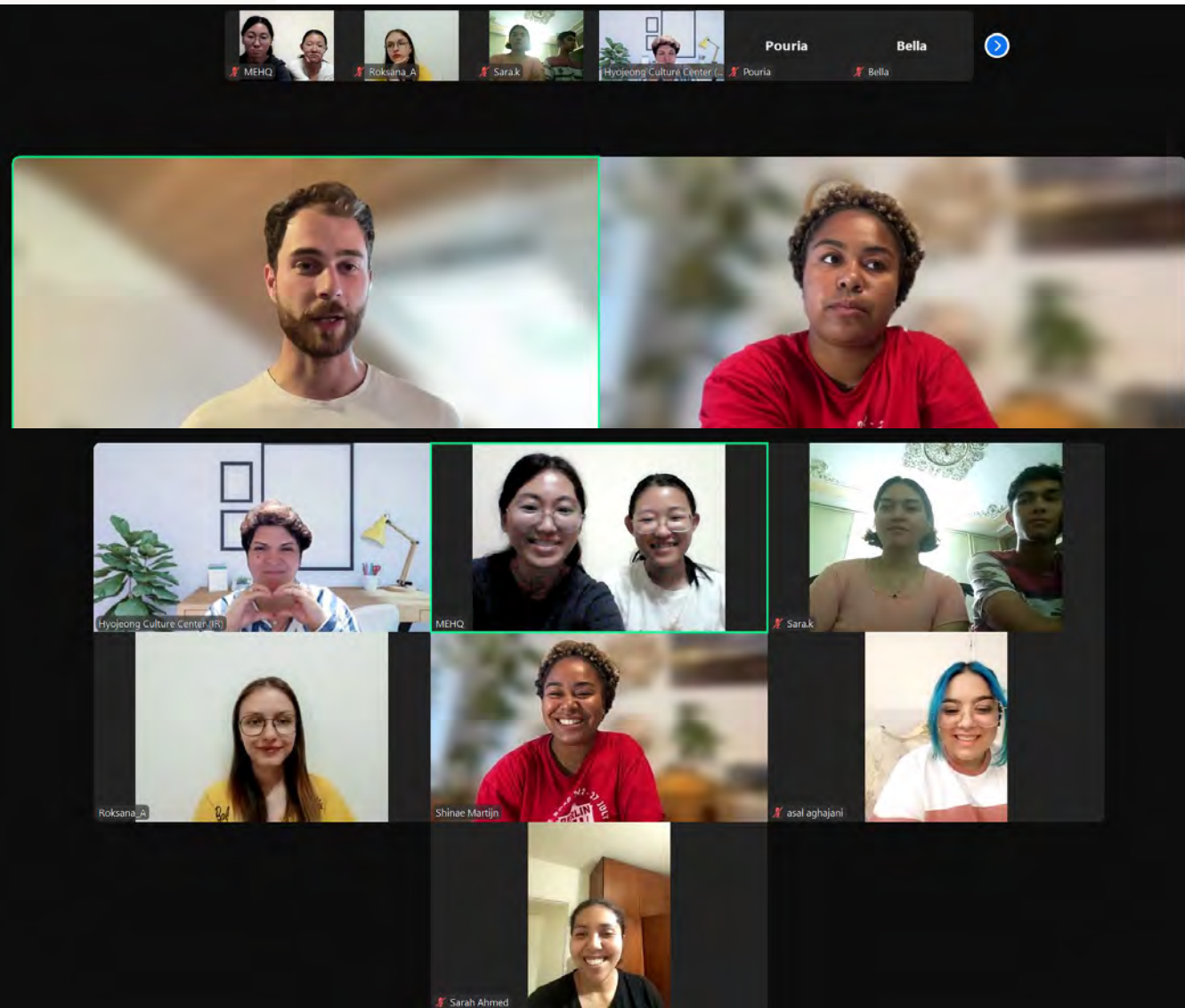


YSP Lebanon : Japanese Culture Event at Manara Youth Center
