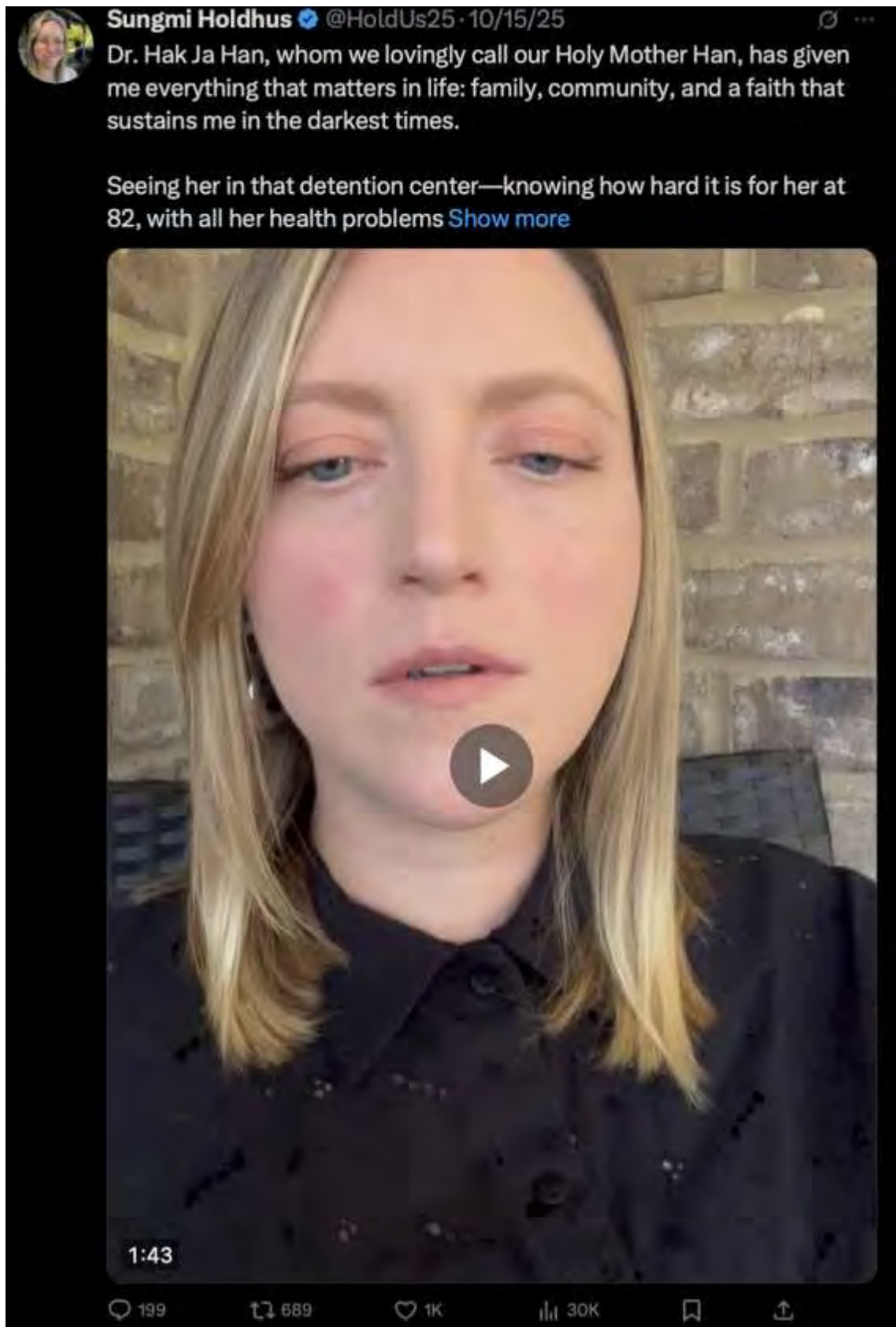

Video Testimony Guide: “Release the Mother of Peace”


We are collecting short video testimonies to raise awareness about **Dr. Hak Ja Han’s unjust detention** in South Korea. As an 82-year-old humanitarian and faith leader, she deserves compassion, dignity, and freedom. Your story can move hearts and inspire action. 1 How to Record

Prepare

- Keep your video 1–2 minutes long.
- Speak from the heart — no script needed. If you wrote a letter, you can read it out on camera.
- Smile, breathe, and be yourself.

Set Up

- Use your phone’s camera in vertical mode like this 
- Find a quiet, bright place with light on your face. Outside is great as long as it’s not noisy.
- Rest your phone on something steady (books or a stand). You can also hold it if your hand is steady.
- Look at the camera lens, not the screen.

Record

- Start with: “My name is [Your Name] from [City/Country]...”
- Speak slowly and clearly.
- Don’t worry about being perfect — sincerity matters most.

Check & Send

- Watch once to ensure sound and light are good.

2 What to Say (Talking Points)

Introduce Yourself

- “My name is ____ from ____.”

Share Why She Inspires You

- How she has inspired your life personally (ex. Receiving the Marriage Blessing, mission work, etc.)
- She has dedicated her life to bringing people of all faiths and nations together.
- Her message of living for the sake of others has touched millions.

Share Why Her Detention Matters

- Dr. Hak Ja Han is 82 years old and in fragile health — this is a humanitarian issue, not just a legal one. She has been held in the Seoul Detention Center for almost a month in inhumane conditions for an elderly person (cold, damp room with no bed, no sunlight, no chair or wheelchair for her to sit in). She needs to be released to receive the care she needs.
- No elderly woman who has lived a life of peacebuilding should face this kind of treatment.
- This is about compassion, fairness, and respect for religious freedom.





Your Hope or Prayer

- I pray for her swift release and for peace in Korea.
- May all people of conscience speak up for her freedom.

End with a Message of Unity

- We stand for freedom of faith and human dignity.
- Let us come together to release the Mother of Peace.

3 Helpful Reminders

-  Keep your camera steady and at eye level
-  Make sure your face is bright and clear
-  Turn off background noise
-  Speak from your heart — sincerity is powerful
