This year's slogan is "Safe blood for all." This global holiday was established in 2004 by the World Health Organization, dedicated to thanking voluntary blood donors and raising awareness for the need for safe blood.

Did you know:

One blood donation can save up to 3 lives

Someone needs blood every 2 seconds

One unit of blood can be separated into several components: red blood cells, plasma, platelets and cryoprecipitate

Red blood cells can only be stored for 42 days

Platelets can only be stored for 5 days

Blood centers often run short of type O and B red cells

One person can donate blood every few months (click here for more info)

If 1% more of Americans donated blood, blood shortages would disappear

Give Blood

Before heading off to donate blood, first check if you fill the <u>eligibility requirements</u>. On this same page, you can also find common reasons some people are unable to donate blood.

Once you're clear to donate blood, find a <u>Red Cross</u> or <u>Vitalant</u> near you. For the Northeast region, there's another blood drive called <u>Community Blood Services</u>.
