ACLC's prayer breakfast in Brooklyn, NY prepares for Peace Starts With Me rally

Keynote speaker Rev. Lawrence Aker III, senior pastor of Cornerstone Baptist Church in Brooklyn, also spoke, sharing that fear should not stop anyone from staying on God's course because fear derives from Satan. "Satan wants us to have fear," said Rev. Aker. "He wants us to run from peace. But God gives us the power to overcome that fear."
