

Presentation of Unification Thought at Zilina University

On Monday, 28th November 2016 our movement was able to present the family ethics of our movement to students of the philosophical faculty at the University of Zilina.

The docent of Lutheran theology knows us since several years and had invited us to hold four lectures at her faculty in Bratislava. She announced to her students one week earlier that followers of Reverend Moon would come and that they should do some research in

advance. About 40 students of theology and religious studies listened attentively for one-and-half hours in the auditorium. The atmosphere was very relaxed and for a short time also the head of the department came and listened.

Milos Klas outlined the principles for an ethical life based on the Divine Principle. At the end, there was a short question and answer session, we recommended websites for further research, handed out information material, six students took True

Father's autobiography. A few students remained and we answered their profound questions in a facility nearby.

Recently our movement received much persecution by the Slovak media and so we were very happy to get such an opportunity to correct the distorted image. We distributed to all students the FOREF press release rebuking the unfair press coverage and the recent government restrictions on religious freedom.
