



Hometown Activity Lecture about "The Universe and its Origin"

Salzburg, Austria, August 19, 2019

t is the fifth year that I use summer holidays for teaching activities in my home village near Salzburg. Since my last two lectures focused on animals (Animals and People) and angels (Guardian angels and Demons) it seemed fitting to speak detailed about the Creator. Most people believe in God, but they do not really know Him. Who, what and where is God? The answers are very vague and lack substance of evidence. Despite existing knowledge and insights, I sweated a lot to collect material for the 90-minutes lecture which was scheduled for Monday, 19th August. How to explain complicated processes in simple words? How to explain JHWH - the "Unspeakable"? I searched the book "Does God Exist?" by the famous Catholic theologian Hans Kueng, but

found nothing to be of use. So, I focused on the explanations of The Divine Principle, especially about the Universal Prime Force and the Polarities and combined them with scientific finds about the structure of the cosmos. I added some comments on the views of atheist scientists who are dominating the public discussions and articles.

Until the very last minute I was not sure if the topic would attract many guests; the response to my mailings, posters and leaflets and newspaper advertisements had not been promising. So, I was very happy that the lecture room in the local Farming Museum became filled, altogether 27 persons. And though I used only my body for explaining the polarity of God, macrocosm and microcosm and similar points, people listened concentrated and nobody dozed off. Indeed, it seemed that the Universal

Prime Force had settled in the room! During the second part I presented testimonies from Paul Mc Cartney, St. Augustine and others, including my own personal encounter with God in outer space. Our brother Gottfried who had come from far away, enriched the gathering with lovely songs and created a seminar-style atmosphere. The guests received some papers with texts about God from the book "True Family Values" and my 5-page manuscript. Worthy to mention is that some devout Catholic churchgoers had come though they had heard some rumors. Some guests wrote me mails that they had been deeply inspired and want to bring guests to my next lecture. One lady had even postponed a trip in order to come; she wrote that she hardly could sleep during the night being so excited about the lecture.
