Cain's Children gives a comprehensive insight into the emotional components of fratricide in the broadest sense – beginning with the biblical story of the murder of Abel right up to the standoff between capitalism and communism. There are countless examples of Cain-Abel conflicts in the history of Christianity in Europe. The book's contents focus on European history, notably the reasons for the rise of Marxism and Communism as a tool to destroy the foundations of faith and substance: In order to prevent God's work of salvation, Satan needed a person through whom he could work, as well as a worldview with which he could separate mankind from God. The right time for his offensive came when the split of Christian society was consummated after the Reformation.

Individual chapters: Cosmic Tug-of-War. Providential Role Play. Inherited Patterns of Erroneous Behaviour. Capitalist Society and Mammon Worship. The Struggle for Justice. The Second Oldest Religion. The Destruction of the Foundation of Faith. The World Empire of Militant Atheism, and more.
