Media's False Image Triggered the Dissolution of the Family Federation

Symposium on Religion, Media, and Human Rights Held in Toyama

A public symposium titled "Considering Religion, Media, and Human Rights" was held on 14th May at the Toyama Family Church of the <u>Family Federation for World Peace and Unification</u> (formerly the <u>Unification Church</u>) in Toyama City.

Speakers included author Fumihiro Kato (加藤文宏); Toru Goto (後藤徹), a member and representative of the <u>National Association of Victims of Abduction and Forced De-Conversion</u>; and Mamoru Kamono (鴨野守), a freelance journalist and executive director of the Toyama Peace Ambassadors Council, a group related to the religious organization.

The speakers shared the view that distorted media reporting contributed to the court's decision to issue a <u>dissolution order</u> for the <u>Family Federation</u>.

Kato argued that, following the 2022 shooting of former Prime Minister Shinzo Abe (安倍晋三), the media suddenly began reporting on ties between the <u>religious organization</u> and politicians, creating a "false image" of the <u>organization</u>. He warned,

"At this point, it's as if <u>Family Federation</u> members no longer have human rights. Unless politicians, the judiciary, and the media correct themselves, this issue will persist for decades."

Kamono claimed that the Kishida administration's declaration of severing ties with the <u>organization</u> was the result of media going wild, and he appealed to the journalists present:

"Please report on religion and faith without prejudice."

Toru Goto, who was a victim of <u>abduction and confinement</u> for <u>12 years and 5 months</u>, criticized the Tokyo District Court's <u>dissolution ruling</u> for not considering cases of <u>abduction and confinement</u>. He warned,

"If things stay as they are, it will become socially acceptable to confine people just because they are <u>Unification Church</u> members."

He emphasized,

"This is not a problem concerning just one religious organization."

The symposium was hosted by the Toyama Peace Ambassadors Council, and about 150 people attended. According to organizers, holding a public symposium inside a church facility is rare even on a national level. They stated, "We wanted members of the media to see the church as it truly is."




Member of clergy warns authorities that dissolving a religious organization based solely on media manipulation and public impression, could easily lead to dissolution of Christian churches and Buddhist groups



In response to the Tokyo District Court's issuance of a dissolution order for the Family Federation for World Peace and **Unification** (formerly the Unification Church), a group called the "Okinawa Citizens' Association for the Protection of Fundamental Human Rights and Freedom of Religion", made up of followers of the religious organization, held a rally on 13th May in front of the Okinawa Prefectural Government Office in Naha City. Speakers at the event appealed, saying,

"Don't be swayed by biased views – listen to the voices of the believers as well."

Taking the microphone as a guest speaker, Pastor Ryuichi Sunagawa (砂川竜一) of *Tsukishiro Christian Church* (located in Nanjo City) passionately argued,

"If the former Unification Church, which hasn't committed any criminal acts, is forcibly dissolved, it is a crisis for democracy."

He also touched upon the assassination of former Prime Minister Shinzo Abe, pointing out,

"The media did not go after the suspect, Tetsuya Yamagami, but instead shifted the criticism against the religious organization."

He warned,

"If an organization can be dissolved based solely on media manipulation and public impression, then Christian churches, Buddhist temples, and ultimately even Shinto shrines could all face dissolution."
