

Updating the Belvedere Family Church Mission Statement!



Dear Brothers and Sisters,

A couple of weeks ago, we let you know that we will soon begin a process to update our Belvedere Family Church Mission Statement. As was explained in that letter, even though a National Mission Statement exists, the situation in each local community is different. Therefore the way our community works towards various national and international goals will be different than say, Chicago or Boston.

That's why it is important for us to decide, together and in the context of everything around us:



The answer to that question will be encapsulated in our Mission Statement (MS) and that's why your opinion is valuable and needed!

Here's how it will work:

On November 12th, a group of 25 people from our community will assemble at Belvedere for the Mission Statement creation project. Participants include Dr. Kone, the paid staff of Belvedere Family Church, representatives from the Council and each of the BFC committees and ministries such as Kodan, Youth Ministry, Sunday Service, Sunday School, etc. and two members from the community-at-large, who do not represent a specific ministry or committee (elected by you).


The project will take about three hours and is a structured and professionally guided process including a review of community input, a question and answer section and then the combining and editing of all responses.

We are expecting that this process will create a one sentence mission statement that will simply and concisely express the mission of BFC.

The new MS will offer guidance, context and a common reference point as we organize our various activities programs and goals.
