

# About Intergenerational Blessing

## *A Personal Reflection*

Blessed Children are encouraged to seek the Blessing only with other Blessed Children. Of course, someday in the future, Blessed Children might be told otherwise. But for now, they are encouraged to only go to the Blessing with other Blessed Children. Why is this so?

Though there may be other reasons why Blessed Children are encouraged to pursue the Blessing only with other Blessed Children, this article will only focus on one reason: Protecting and strengthening the foundation of the Blessing Providence. (Or is that two reasons. Anyway.)

Protecting and strengthening the foundation of the Blessing Providence is another way of saying protecting, strengthening and expanding God's lineage.

The reason why Blessed Children should be blessed with other Blessed Children is in order to deepen the victorious foundation established by the True Parents of Heaven, Earth and Humankind.

True Parents' foundation is supposed to expand horizontally and vertically, mainly through the Blessing. Each generation that receives the Blessing expands True Parents' foundation horizontally as well as vertically. For instance, when First Generation singles (as well as married couples) receive the Blessing, they expand the foundation of the Blessing horizontally and vertically. The horizontal expansion can grow wider with the number of First Generations who have received the Blessing. However, the vertical expansion, or the depth of the foundation stops at that one single stage for First Generations. It is Blessed Children who are supposed to further the vertical growth of True Parents' foundation. At this stage of the providence, this is only efficient if Blessed Children receive the Blessing

with other Blessed Children.

Once again, through the Blessing of First Generations, the vertical foundation grows only but one degree. Meaning that the vertical foundation of the Blessing grows one degree by generation. In other words, through the Blessing of First Generations, God's lineage can only grow one degree vertically but can expand horizontally as wide as the number of First Generations who receive the Blessing.

With each generation increasing the depth of the Blessing foundation one degree at a time, the pool of Blessed Couples created among Blessed Children has to, within a certain providential timeframe, exceed the number of First Generations Blessed Couples.

The more Blessed Children receive the Blessing with First Generations or Jacob Generations, the longer it will take to achieve the expansion of God's lineage with any of the True Parents still alive on this earth. With True Father already in the spiritual world, we need to take the ephemeral opportunity we have with True Mother to solidify God's lineage through securing and deeply grounding the foundation of the Blessing centering on our True Mother. We should not forget that our True Parents are still setting heavenly standards. There is no way that Satan can compromise the standard of the Blessing. Neither can he compromise God's lineage as established by our True Parents. Whatever confusion Satan can create while True Mother is still alive, True Mother will deal with it even with the existing foundation. However, when True Mother transitions to the spiritual world, there will be neither True Father nor True Mother to directly respond to Satan's gimmicks physically. This is why, it is very important that we solidify the victorious foundation of True Parents while we still have True Mother physically with us. This can be quickly achieved by expanding and deepening the foundation of the Blessing.

### **How Many Layers Deep?**

So, in order to solidify the foundation of the Blessing, there should be proportional horizontal and vertical growth. Horizontal growth means

width—How wide is the foundation? Vertical foundation means depth—How deep or profound is the foundation? This is what determines the strength and longevity of our 'True Parents' foundation.

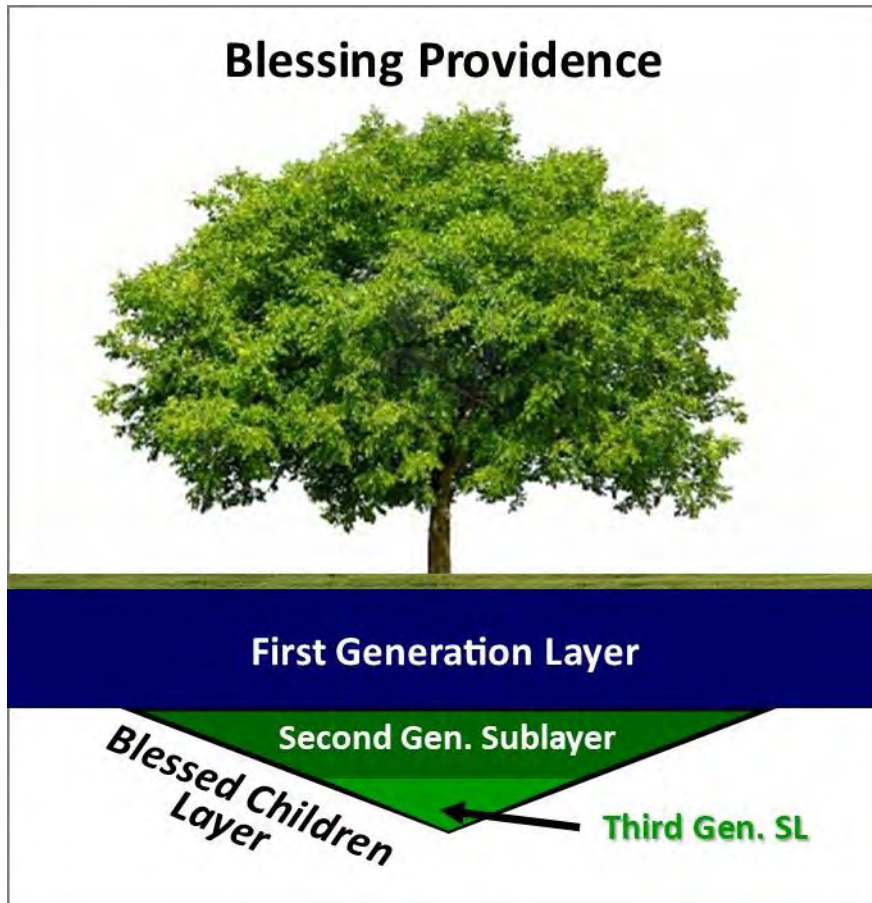

With Blessed Children being blessed with other Blessed Children, 'True Parents' foundation does not only expand horizontally, but vertically as well. This means that each layer, First Generation Layer, Second Generation Sublayer, Third Generation Sublayer, etc., adds base and depth to 'True Parents' victorious foundation—God's lineage.

A Blessed Child who goes to the Blessing with a First Generation single will belong to the First Generation Layer. Except if the First Generation single was sexually pure physically and spiritually. Meaning that this person must be a virgin who has never had sexual intercourse and also has never had sexual improprieties. In this latter case, the Blessed Child

and the First Generation single will have to go through a series of jeongseongs set by our True Parents. After successfully completing the required jeongseongs, then and only then, will they belong to the Blessed Children Layer and contribute deepening 'True Parents' victorious foundation.

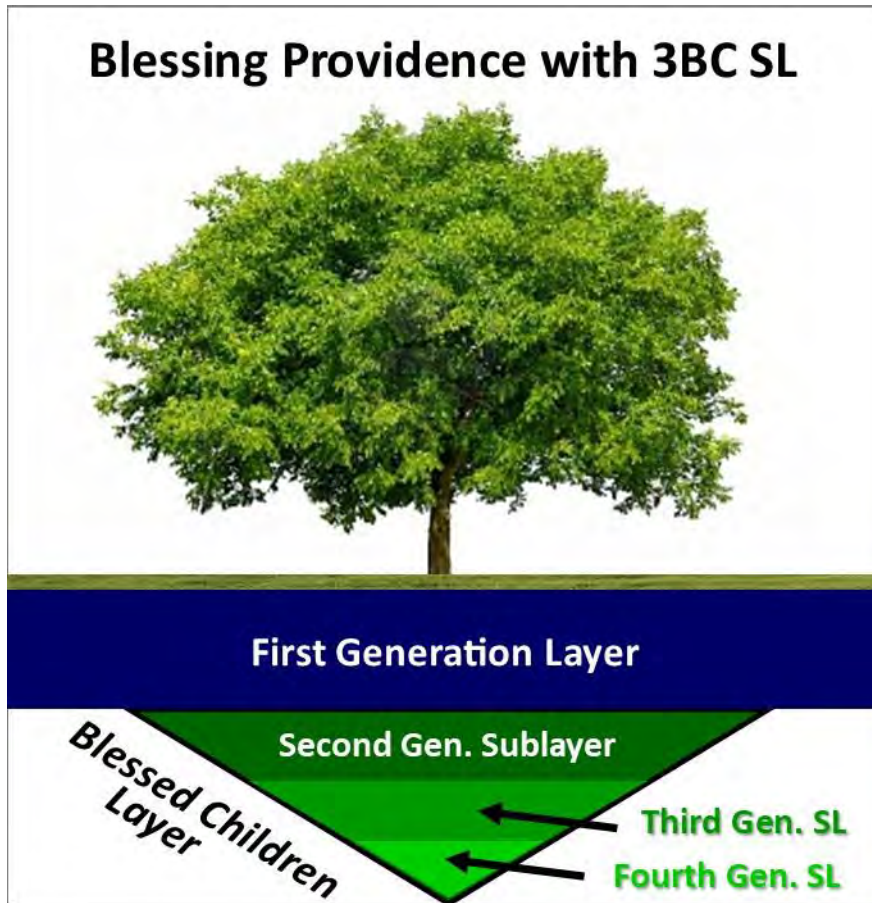

There are two major layers when it comes to deepening the depth of True Parents' victorious Foundation: The First Generation Layer and the Blessed Children Layer. The First Generation Layer is one layer without subdivisions. The Blessed Children Layer is one layer with subdivisions such as Second Generation Sublayer, Third Generation Sublayer, Fourth Generation Sublayer, etc. All these layers form the roots of this big tree that is 'True Parents' victorious foundation.

Though it can grow wider, the First Generation Layer cannot grow

any deeper than it already is. However, the Blessed Children Layer is supposed to continue to grow deeper with every new generation created by the unions of Blessed Children. This is why it is very crucial that Blessed Children be blessed with other Blessed Children, regardless of their generation.

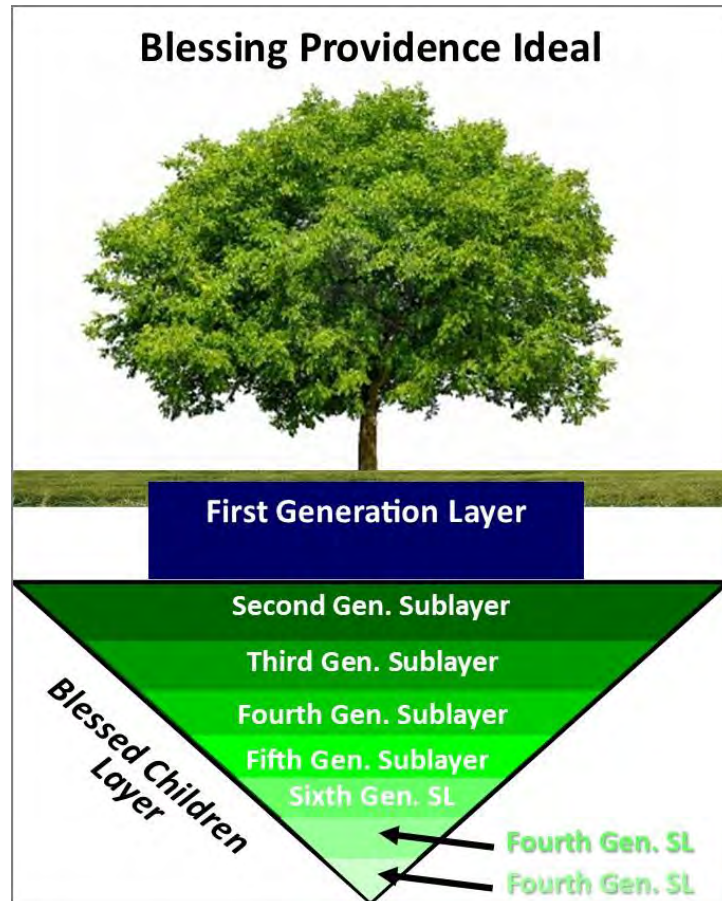

Each generation of Blessed Children strengthens the root of the Blessing Providence not only by deepening it vertically, but also by expanding it horizontally. Eventually, the number of living Blessed Children will exceed that of living First Generations. This will cause the Blessed Children Layer to be deeper and wider than the First Generation Layer.

Right now, the First Generation Layer is still wider than the Blessed Children Layer. It will be safer if the Blessed Children Layer grows deeper



and wider than the First Generation Layer while our True Mother is still physically with us.

Because the Blessed Children Layer is one big layer of all the generations of God's lineage, it is alright if a Blessed Child who is a Second Gen., for instance, receives the Blessing with another Blessed Child who is a Third Gen. This is because such a Blessing will further the expansion of the Blessed Children Layer. However, when a Blessed Child receives the Blessing with a First Gen., that Blessed Child will be contributing to the expansion of the First Generation Layer, which can only expand horizontally; not vertically. This means that instead of this Blessed Child expanding God's lineage vertically by giving birth to a Third Gen., this Blessed Child will give birth to another Second Gen. instead. Which is alright, except that God and True Parents have been robbed of the opportunity of seeing the fruits of their labor grow efficiently.

Just think about what would have happened to the legacy of True Father if True Mother was not around. All that True Mother is doing is crossing the t's and dotting the i's as pertaining to the mission of the True Parents.

Just like God and our True Parents, every First Generation Blessed Couple would also like to see the fruits of their work grow. They would like to see their Blessed Grandkids, Blessed Great Grandkids. They would like to see as many generations of Blessed Children as possible connected to their physical lineage before they transition into the spiritual world. Don't we think that the True Parents desire the same thing?

We have the power to make it happen.
