

Universal Peace Federation Albania introduced in Librazhd town

5 AGUST 2014, LIBRAZH, ALBANIA



On Tuesday, August 5th UPF Albania was introduced in Librazhd town, a city 70 km from the capital Tirana, through the initiative by a local ambassador for peace supported by elbasan Peace Council.

As it's summer time the event begun at 6 PM in a family atmosphere with local representatives chaired by the Mayor, Mr. Shefqet Çota. A delegation from UPF Albania headquarters including the secretary general Mr. S. Rexhepi and Mrs. Saemira Pino (vice chair of UPF AI) and Mrs. Lavdie Ruci (member of UPF Presideing Council) joined from Tirana.

The meeting was opened by Mrs. Fatbardha Alimeta, the initiator of the event who is the head of Social Services of the town. Then the chair of Elbasan LPC Mrs. Eva Nita welcomed the participants and explained about the meaning and tasks of an ambassador for peace.

Another lady, Mr. Pino than described the path of UPF Albania from 2005 with father Moon's visit in Tirana until 2014. This presentation, featuring many photos, was followed with special interest by the participants.



Afterwards Mr. Rexhepi explained in 15 minutes the core principles of UPF and the funder's vision. At the end five distinguished individuals received the Ambassador for Peace award. Among them was the national famous singer Mrs. Ermira Babaliu who lives in USA for 18 years now, where she is very active with the Albanian community there especially in charity activities. Lately she was trying to establish a social bussines in her hometown of Pogradec. The other people were the Mayor, a school principal a sculptor and an NGO leader.
