The HOS, working with support staff, is:

- The moral leader of the school
- The legal representative of the governing boards on the school site
- Responsible for creating and following a budget
- The instructional leader
- Responsible for the hiring, firing, and training of school employees

Preferred qualifications:

- A master's degree or higher
- Teaching experience
- Fiscal competence in managing budgets and long-term strategic plans
- A Unificationist

Special skills needed:

- Be a moral exemplar and conceive the job as a mission in service to humanity.
- Articulate to all stakeholders the vision of TPA as a school focused on character education and social/emotional learning.
- Respect parents as the child's first teachers and collaborate as partners with them.

Lines of supervision: The Head of School is responsible to the Board of Trustees and must be evaluated by them annually utilizing a written instrument, which becomes part of the Head's permanent file.
