D. Participants' Qualifications:

1. Each continent or region should send the selected representatives to World Peace Cup Martial Arts Tournament 2010. They should go through continental or equivalent tournament. Theses continents or regions are Korea, Japan, China, Africa, Asia, Eurasia, Europe, North America, Oceania and South America.
2. Age should be 15 ~ 35 years old.
3. Internal qualification (motivation for world peace, pure love, and family values) should be certified by the Continental TIMD Leader.

E. Competition Categories:

1. Sparring Competition: Man-Semi-full contact by TIMD Sparring Rules and with Protective Equipments * (*Each participant should bring own mouth groin cap.)

Division:	Men
i. Fin Weight Division	54.9 kg ~ Below
ii. Fly Weight Division	55 kg ~ 59.9 kg
iii. Bantam Weight Division	60 kg ~ 64.9 kg
iv. Feather Weight Division	65 kg ~ 69.9 kg
v. Light Weight Division	70 kg ~ 74.9 kg
vi. Welter Weight Division	75 kg ~ 79.9 kg
vii. Middle Weight Division	80 kg ~ 84.9 kg
viii. Heavy Weight Division	85 kg ~ Above

(Note: Women's Division for Free Sparring Competition is not Included this time.)

2. Form Competition = individual (men, women) and group
3. Special Techniques Competition = individual or group

F. Accommodations, Food and Transportation:

These will be provided by Woung Peace Cup Committee.

* In case some delegates of staff come early (arriving Korea before October 8) or leave later (departure from Korea after October 14) they should take charge of their own food and accommodation.

G. Tournament Fees:

1. Participate 1 category ----- \$ 40
2. Participate 2 categories ----- \$ 60

4. Participate 4 categories ----- \$ 75
5. Participate 5 categories ----- \$ 80

G. Others:

All costs for transportation for the selected participants should be covered by the participants themselves or by each continental or regional TIMD office. The selection should be made through a championship tournament in each continent/region not later than September 1 at the latest. The results should be sent to WTMF by September 7, 2010 in order to prepare Korean visas for the participants. All participants are required to have full understanding of the “New Philosophy for the Martial Arts” and to pass preliminary examinations in each continent/region.
