## UPF-Sri Lanka's Youth Building Peace event for UN International Youth Day 2017

Galle, Sri Lanka -- "Youth Building Peace" was the theme of an event UPF-Sri Lanka held to celebrate the UN International Youth Day.

UPF in partnership with Sri Lanka's Ministry of Lands and Parliamentary Reforms, the UN Information Centre (UNIC) Colombo, Youth and Students for Peace (YSP), Religious Youth Service (RYS) and the Global Youth Service Foundation organized the program, which took place on August 12, 2017 at the Management Training and Development Center in Wakella, Galle, a city on the southwestern tip of Sri Lanka.
