2017 marked the kick-off of the Art Camp Croatia (ACC) and I'm very happy to be able to continue this project in 2019 after very successful ACC18.

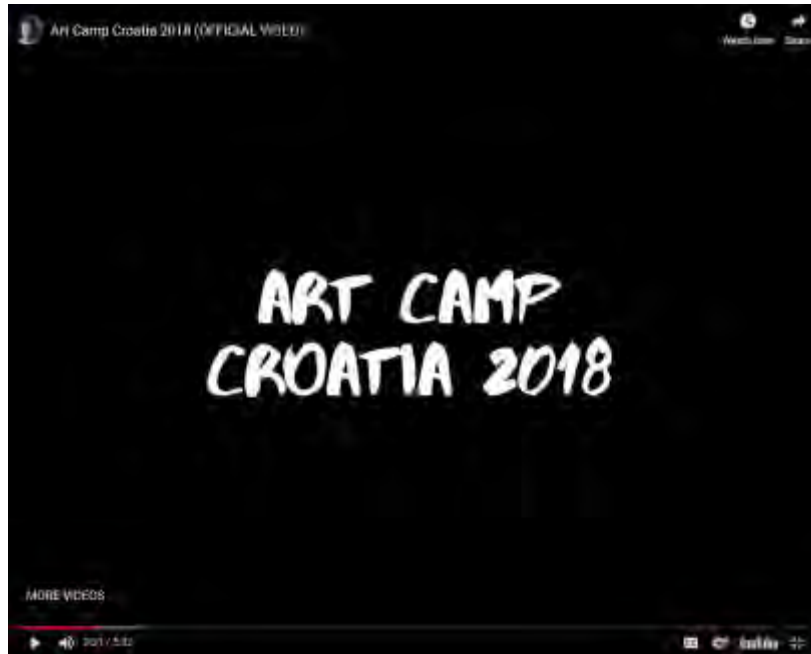
