Monrovia, Liberia - In collaboration with the National Association of Social Workers of Liberia, UPF-Liberia celebrated the Global Day of Parents on June 30, 2025 with a one-day workshop held at the University of Liberia's Capitol Hill Campus in Monrovia.

The event brought together 53 students and alumni from four universities in Monrovia, focusing on professional development, with presentations on leadership, ethics, financial practices, organizational performance, and conflict resolution. A highlight was the impactful session on Peacebuilding and Conflict Resolution led by the UPF-Liberia secretary.
