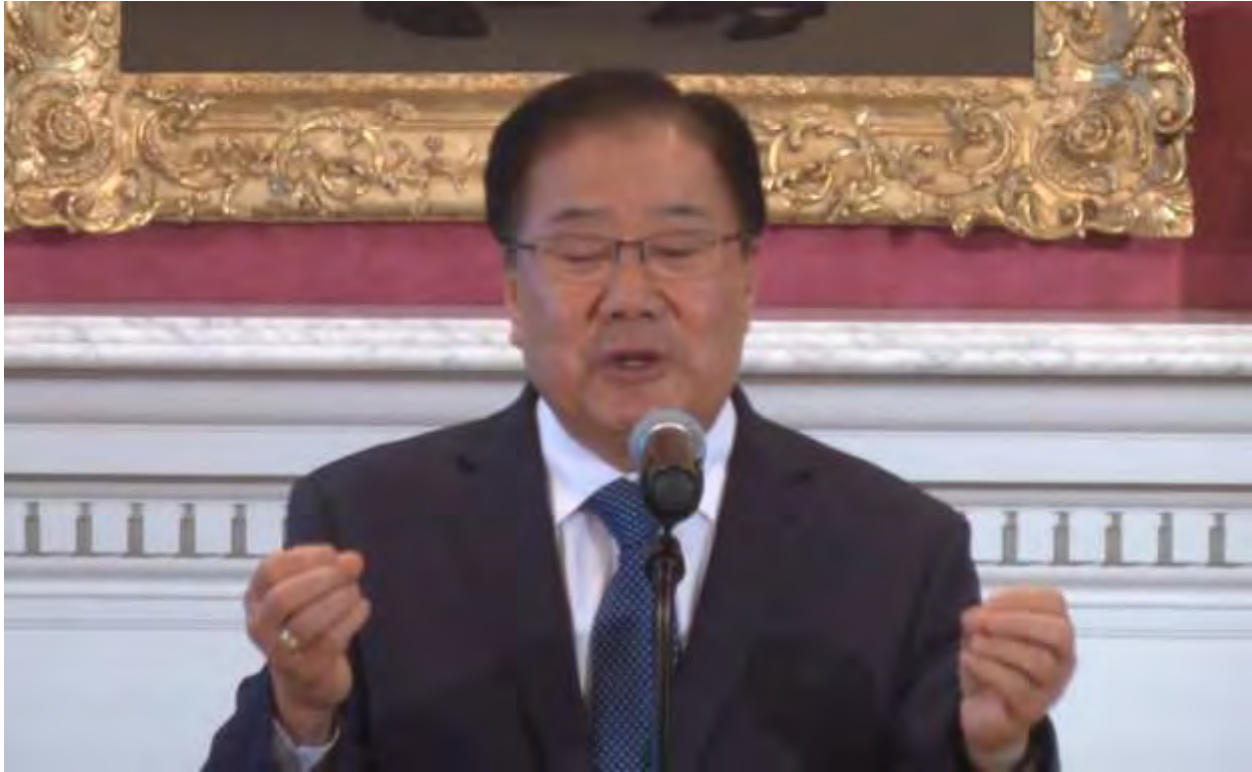


Ki Hoon Kim delivers the Washington, D.C. Family Church's Sunday Service
