Sunhyun is off of all IV sedatives at the moment, which is a precondition for him leaving the ICU! They have him on two oral medications instead that serve to keep patients calm / stable (seroquel and clonidine) and are monitoring to see how he tolerates that.

I was in his room for the last two hours and this is the most awake and alert I've seen him. He was looking around, lifting his head, making eye contact and generally seemed much more himself than he has before.

My mom, Godfrey and I were trying various prompts with him and seemed to be having some luck with asking him to open and close his mouth. We know it will be a long road of recovery but overall I'm feeling very good and hopeful right now.

21-Day Prayer for Sunhyun

We would like to invite you all to join us in a 21 day prayer condition starting this coming Monday, September 23 and going through Sunday, October 13, 2024 (the 40th day after Sunhyun's cardiac arrest on September 4th). It will consist of at least 7 minutes prayer each night on the following prayer points:

- 1. For Sunhyun's mind and body to be healed and for Sunhyun to experience a complete recovery, mentally and physically, on the fastest time frame compatible with God's will.
- 2. For Sunhyun's higher neurological functions to be restored and for him to be present with us mentally as well as physically. For Sunhyun's true self to return and for the bright light of Sunhyun's heart and personality to shine forth once again.
- 3. For Sunhyun's doctors (including his ICU doctors, neurologists, cardiologists and infectious disease specialists), nurses, physical therapists, occupational therapists and other medical staff to provide the best possible care for him to maximize his recovery.
- 4. For Sunhyun to be transferred at the appropriate time from the Beth Israel ICU to a top Long Term Acute Care (LTAC) facility with specialization in brain injury rehabilitation.
 - 5. In particular, we pray that he be transferred to the Spaulding Hospital for Continuing Medical Care in Cambridge, which is a leading hospital nationally for neuro rehab.
 - 6. We pray that Dr. Alexandra Stillman from Spaulding will be moved to take on Sunhyun's case or direct his family to the best rehabilitation program for him.
- 7. For the health and safety of Sunhyun, Yeol-Shim, the families and all those supporting them. For the protection of those traveling to and from the Boston area.
- 8. For Sunhyun, Yeol-Shim and the families to have unity, strength and stamina for this journey of recovery. That they can create beautiful memories and experience joy with one another even at this challenging time.
- 9. For Sunhyun, Yeol-Shim and the families to feel the love and supportive presence of God, the heavenly spiritual world, their community, caregivers, friends and extended family.
