Information of '2014 Sun Moon University Scholarship Program for International Students for Korean Language & Undergraduate Course

1. Program Objective

The objective of the Sun Moon University Scholarship Program for Korean Language & Undergraduate Course is to provide international students with the opportunity to conduct advanced studies at higher educational institutions in Sun Moon University in order to support founder's intent to strengthen 2nd generation education, building global network and activating exchange.

2. Academic Programs

Undergraduate degree courses for four years after successfully completing a one-year (or one and a half years) Korean Language Education in Sun Moon University, Korea.

3. Fields of Study<Refer to the attached file "Field of Study">

4. Qualifications of applicants for scholarship program

Prospective applicants must meet the following qualification criteria:

- (1) Must be a citizen of the country to which scholarships are offered.
 - (Applicants must not be a holder of Korean citizenship)
- (2) Have an adequate health, both physically and mentally.
 ※ Persons who are pregnant or having severe illness may not apply.
- (3) Have finished or be scheduled to finish formal education of high school.
- (4) Will be recommended by National Leader or Continental Leader of church.

5. Tuition and Scholarship Benefit per year

(1) Korean Language course: The whole tuition of Korean Language course will be provided by Church Foundation. (Room, meals and personal expenses should be paid by the students.)

(2) Undergraduate course: If the student's academic score is higher than 3.0 (B), they will receive the 70% of tuition from Church Foundation and 30% from Sun Moon University as the scholarship. (Room, meals and personal expenses should be paid by the students.)

Academic score is calculated as follows.

(3) Notes : Students will receive the scholarship when they fulfill following conditions.

- ① Students have to continue to study at the undergraduate course of Sun Moon University after completion of Korean Language course. The length of Korean Language course is 1 year and can be extended half a year more if necessary.
- ② During the Korean Language course, Students have to attend in every class (The ratio of attendance has to exceed 90% of class time) including summer and winter session. If a student has any special reason to absent in a class, he/she has to get the permission of teacher before.
- ③ Students have to attend in Sunday service which is offered by the church of Sun Moon University. (The ratio of attendance has to exceed 90%)
- ④ Students have to attend in education program which is offered by the Wonmo Pyeongae Foundation.

9. Other Important things

(1) Entry

- ① Grantees must arrive in Korea until Feb 25, 2014. In case a grantee does not enter Korea by the date stated above without any special reason, his/her scholarship award will be cancelled.
- Prior to arrival, grantees should acquire some knowledge about the Korean climate, customs, culture, etc

- Entry & Residence http://immigration.go.kr.
 ③ Grantees are required to get a visa (D-4) before arriving in Korea.

* Visit the Consular section of the Korean embassy or consulate in your country of residence with the invitation letter from Sun Moon University, after being informed of selection as a grantee.

④ Every grantee should read this information thoroughly before coming to Korea and keep it for reference while staying in Korea, which will be distributed prior to arriving in Korea.

(5) Every grantee is advised to prepare enough money to cover the boarding expenses and the personal expenses for the studying period. Extra work or part time job does not allowed during the Korean Language courses.

(2) Housing

- 1 Grantees would reside in a university dormitory.
- ② Each room will be shared by 4 students.
- (3) Korean Language Course
 - ① Duration: First Semester 2014 : March 3, 2014 ~ June 18,2014
 - 2 Institution: Korean Language Institute at Sun Moon University

- **③** Notes.
 - The grantee should have a 3rd level of Korean Language Proficiency Test when he/she applies to the university entrance. Otherwise, scholarship may be cancelled.
- (4) Undergraduate Degree Program
 - ① Duration: March 2, 2015 ~ February 28, 2019
 - 2 Notes
 - The grantee should make a preparation of the another required documents for application for an admission to a university if necessary.
- (5) Cancellation or suspension of Scholarship
 - ① If a grantee is found engaged in any of the following activities during his/her stay in Korea, his/her scholarship will be suspended and then will be disqualified from a grantee position.
 - When any documents of the scholarship application has been found false.
 - When the grantee is punished by the university or involved in any form of political activity.
 - When the grantee has violated the written pledge which s/he has given to Sun Moon University.
 - When the grantee has violated the guidelines and regulations set by Sun Moon University.
 - When the grantee has been cautioned more than 2 times due to an unexcused absence or a prolonged absence from the Korean language training or the temporary departure without permission or notification
 - When the grantee has not earned at least 18 registered credit courses (in case of 1st year, 12 registered credit courses) of the semester and average score of semester is below than B in the undergraduate course.
 - When the grantee has given up one's studies.
 - When they refuse to study at the Sun Moon university after s/he finished his/her Korean language course.

12. Q&A

(1) Is it possible to start off by studying Korean for a year, and then decide to go for the 4-year program, or is it a 5 year commitment from the start?

 \Rightarrow After completion of Korean language course, those who achieve TOPIK(Test of Proficiency in Korean) level 3 can apply for admission of undergraduate course at Sun Moon University. The qualification for admission is a graduate from high school in their country.

(2) If I already have credits from the USA, can they be transferred to Korea?

 \Rightarrow Yes. The credits you got from the USA are accepted. However when a student transfer, the grade is decided depend on how many semesters he/she has achieved, not credits. Even if a student has quite credits, it does not reduce credits you need to achieve at Sun Moon University. You can be transferred as second grade if you complete two semesters and you can be transferred as third grade if you complete four semesters.

(3) What about credits I earn in Korea? can they be transferred to US colleges? How do I find out? \Rightarrow It depends on the university you are applying for that how many credits are accepted. The standard is different from universities. It is possible to apply for graduate school in US after you graduate from Sun Moon University.

(4) How many months a year do I need to be in Korea? Is there an expectation that I remain in Korea during the vacation time?

 \Rightarrow When you study at Korean Language Course, you are obligated to stay in Korea even during vacations except for special occasions. But after you enter undergraduate course, you can leave Korea to spend time in your country. In general, the summer vacation is from late June till late August and winter vacation is from middle December till late February.

(5) I understand that there is a scholarship for tuition. But are there other, out of pocket fees or expenses that I should know about?

 \Rightarrow Please refer to the table (#5) for the description of scholarship. The other expenses you need to pay are followed.

O Room and Board : \$3,200 per year (including 10 meals per week): 320 만원

O Insurance Fee: about \$100 (100,000 won) a year: 약 100,000 원

Every international student at Sun Moon University should join insurance service provided by Sun Moon University unless you already join another international insurance service by yourself.

O Orientation Fee(only for freshmen): about \$35 (40,000 won)

O Student Union Fee and the others: about \$20 (22,000 won)

O Graduation Preparation Fee (only for seniors):about \$50 (60,000 won)

(6) What happens to the international students when school is not in session? Where do they sleep? Eat?

 \Rightarrow Those who want to stay in the campus during vacations can stay at dormitory as long as they apply in advance (during session). The dormitory cafeteria is also opened during vacation. After you pay the dorm fee, you can use dormitory cafeteria after purchasing meal tickets.

(7) What is the situation with medical coverage and medical insurance? Can I use the school's health center? What happens if I have a major incident while I am away?

 \Rightarrow There is a health center on the first floor of Student Building in Campus. Both students studying Korean Language course and Undergraduate course can use. The incident happens in Korea can be covered by the insurance. Please refer to the table below for description of medical coverage.

(8) What if two members of the same family wish to apply?

 \Rightarrow The siblings from the same family can take benefit from the same scholarship described above.

9. When does the spring program start?

 \Rightarrow The Academic schedule is different from the courses. 2014 Spring semester of Korean Language course starts on 3th of March. The undergraduate course at Sun Moon University consists of two semesters a year. In general, First (spring) semester is from March to middle June. Second (fall) semester is from September to middle December. The first semester of 2014 is from 3rd of March.
