ur brother Dr Nnamdi Ahunanya the Secretary General of UPF Malta, passed away suddenly in Nigeria, while visiting his family in his home town on January 15th. An Interfaith Memorial Service was held on the 12th February at the Stella Maris College Chapel, a school where his two sons had attended.

Over 100 people attended the event, with testimonies of his life, being shared by the Director of the
