posted, unification.net. In the course of this period, I read the bible extensively, read several scriptures of other world religions and joined several bible-study groups. All these, together with intense prayer and spiritual practices, gradually shed more and more light on the meaning of the Divine Principle until I received the fullest understanding of it – the suffering heart of God – accompanied with inner change.

I joined the church in San Leandro, in the San Francisco Bay Area this year. I didn't join in my home country because the only local church was in another region of the country, North-central, whereas I lived in the South-west.
