UPF Pointe Noire, Congo Brazzaville's 2-day seminar for Ambassadors for Peace

The causes of conflict and violence as well as the foundation of a nation of peace were the themes presented by Reverend Ndielle on the second day of the conference. Mr. Zodji presented five universal principles followed by Ambassadors for Peace.
