Elder Tillie Black Bear, Sicangu Lakota, Wa Wokiye Win (Woman Who Helps Everyone). She was the first Native woman to organize a national movement and educate Congress on domestic violence and the federal trust responsibility to assist Indian tribes in protecting their women.

Chief Arvol and Paula Looking Horse, Teton Lakota, Shunka Wakan Wicasa Chief Looking Horse is internationally recognized as Chief and Spiritual Leader of the Lakota, Dakota, and Nakota Oyate (Great Sioux Nation). Keeper of the White Buffalo sacred bundle. Paula Looking Horse, an accomplished traditional Dakota artist organized the Wopida (Great Thank You) ceremony in 1984. They have given a lifetime of leadership and devotion to the Creator, Great Spirit, Mother Earth, and humanity.

United States Secretary of Interior Deb Haaland, Laguna Pueblo. The first Native American to serve as a cabinet secretary for our country. Dedicated accomplishments focused on environmental justice, climate change, the federal Indian boarding school Initiative, missing and murdered Indigenous women, and family-friendly policies.
