

## WFWP Italy invited to participate in 'Women tell their Stories'

On 3 Dec 2015, the President of WFWP Italy, Elisabetta Nistri was invited as a speaker at a convention organized by the president of the “Occhio dell’arte” association, Lisa Bernardini and Maria Grazia De Angelis, President of the Italian ‘Association of the study of work for organizational Development’.

“WOMEN TELL THEIR STORIES: How women contribute to a “man made” society” was the title of the convention, and the participants included many women from various fields, who seek to spread an ethic, merit based, harmonious and altruistic culture.

The organizers believe that the thoughts and culture that characterize our way of life, having historically been led by a male-oriented viewpoint, need to include the female viewpoint as well. This means we need to integrate various kinds of values, while maintaining respect and identity, and working together to create new social models and a new way to communicate, do and act for a harmonious society.

At the meeting there were many suggestions from female figures who shared their experiences from the professional world and the areas of education and media.

Elisabetta Nistri spoke about the main goals of WFWP and the activities that are being realized in Italy in the past few years, sharing mostly about the experiences she had had working with many great women from many different cultures. The famous journalist, Giovanni Masotti from national TV who was there as Moderator, intrigued by the theme, addressed several questions to Elisabetta Nistri that have attracted the public’s attention. He was particularly interested about how it is possible to realize a world of peace according to the visions of WFWP. Elisabetta Nistri explained that the only solution, even though it may be difficult, is to start to realize and build peace among the family. The family transmits essential values and fundamental education to people. Healthy families in which there is harmony between the couple followed by good relationships with their children are the base for a healthy society.
