Following the devastating earthquake that shook Nepal on 25 April 2015, WFPW Italy started fundraising to fund WFPW Nepal's project to help the reconstruction of many villages that were hit.

Last October 700 euros were sent to help this project. This money was raised by the members, sympathizers and charity events.

In November 2015, WFPW Nepal sent a report telling us about their realized project, the reconstruction of an elementary school that had been completely destroyed in the village of Gorka that is situated 150km away from Kathmandu.

Since the earthquake, students attended school in a tent. With our donation, they could buy the roof and the school could be rebuilt.

In the attached report you can see some photos of the school and how much there is still to do in that village, this is why WFPW Italy plans to continue collecting donations in the new year.
