

WFP Albania - Youth Peace Academy: Personal Development for Leadership

This was the first out of four sessions of this year with the Youth Peace Academy, which was advertised by social media. We received applications from twenty-five people, and eventually ten guests showed up on the day of the program.

The quality of the participants was excellent, ranging between 18 to 35 years old, and all of them showed a lot of interest and appreciation for the content we taught.

The main presentation was complemented by a talk by Mrs. Dorina Prethi, WFP Albania legal advisor and a political activist. Mrs. Prethi shared about the necessity of having a moral and spiritual axis for a successful social and professional life.



Besides the presentations, the session included some interactive activities and questions to speakers.

This meeting was followed by three subsequent ones, all on Saturdays in April, with the topics of "Challenge of Relationships in the Family and Society," "Transformation of Conflicts," and "Vision of Youth as Creators of the Future."

The meetings included presentations by WFP staff and talks by invited guests with experience in social and political life, including former members of parliament. Participants who attended at least three presentations received a certificate of completion.
