She has a doctorate from Boston University and a post-doctorate from Harvard University (1991-93) where she was trained in the Interactive Problem-Solving approach by late Professor Herbert Kelman. She is a scholar/practitioner and taught in many universities abroad and at the Department of Social and Political Sciences of University of Cyprus, for twenty years. She was the first to introduce gender courses and conflict resolution at her department. She has over forty years of experience in peacebuilding and gender and conflict resolution, as well as being a founder or co-founder of many NGOs on gender equality, reconciliation and women, peace and security agenda. Her academic work opened up new ways of analysing protracted complex conflicts, such as the Cyprus conflict.
