Juggling responsibilities, she re-entered the workforce as a caretaker, all the while maintaining the sanctity of our home and actively participating in church services and events.

Her love for art and music manifested in her joyful pursuits of drawing and playing the piano in her youth. As a pianist and singer in the church's Japanese choir, she enriched the lives of those around her. Kazue's legacy lives on as a testament to her tireless work, gentle spirit, and unspoken strength.


