St. Petersburg, Russia -- A meeting titled "Green Angels of St. Petersburg" brought together participants who are passionate about protecting the environment.

The St. Petersburg chapter of UPF held the meeting together with the City Resource Center for Continuing Education titled "Environmental Education as the Most Important Mechanism for Socializing Children and Youth."
