

Pacific Clergy Leadership Conference: 4th Asia-Pacific Nation-Building Seminar

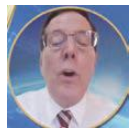
The entire event consisted of special lectures, praise, self-reflection, discussions, interdenominational joint prayer meetings, and commemorative photos. The first part focused on "Heavenly Parent's Dream: Salvation through Blessing," followed by the second part, which centered on discussing "Our Lords Return."

On this day, a total of 810 people from 18 countries in the Asia-Pacific region, including Japan, the United States, Korea, and Burundi, participated in

the seminar through various group watch parties (via Zoom, Facebook, YouTube). Attendees included Dr. Masaichi Hori, President of Heavenly Asia Pacific, and Dr. Robert Kittel.



In his welcoming speech, President Hori expressed gratitude to the participants and emphasized that the values of True Parents' ideal family should be properly taught to all families today to fulfill Heavenly Parent's dream.



Following this, Dr. Robert Kittel, co-chair of PCLC, delivered a special lecture focusing on "The Return of Christ," the fifth sub-theme of the main topic "God's Dream." He took time to explain in detail how Jesus' mission was conveyed through the birth and holy marriage of True Parents, who have devoted their entire lives to promoting a worldwide peace movement to realize the ideal of "One Human Family under Heavenly Parent."
