Next Gen Mission



The missionaries have concluded their workshop in Blanco, Texas, where they learned about True Parent's course from Rev. Hideyuki Sakai.

In the Unification movement, "True Parents" refers to the founders, Reverend Sun Myung Moon and Dr. Hak Ja Han Moon. They are seen as a model of God-centered marriage and family, and through their teachings alongside the Marriage Blessing tradition, they emphasize building families based on true love. This is seen as the foundation for peace. Unificationists affectionately use the term "True Parents" to express their role as spiritual parents to humanity.

It was an intense week. Upon learning and understanding the history of our movement and the impact made on the world, the missionaries were able to absorb a lot, and ask in-depth questions about True Parents.



The week was dense in terms of content, but still full of fun and joy! Next Gen Mission has been blessed with the presence of Rev. Demian Dunkley and Rev. Rendel. The missionaries prepared some songs and performances for these leaders, and Rev. Dunkley was able to share his heart with them.



The day with leadership concluded with Texas BBQ and a stroll down the famous riverwalk in San Antonio.

To help substantiate what the missionaries learned, they had a skit competition! Drawing significant events from True Parents' life in a hat, they then emulated it on stage with their own creative flair. The skits were entertaining, but accurate in depicting what True Parents have done in their lives. Some participants even added actual speeches to further the accuracy of these incredible events.



Now, they are off in the Southern states fundraising for the next two weeks. After, they'll regroup in our new Next Gen property located in Spiceland, Indiana.

Is my donation tax deductible?

Is there a deadline to make my

Yes. Your donation is 100% tax deductible. Next Gen is part of HSA-UWC, which is a 501(c)(3).

Can I make a wire transfer?

Yes, you can make an ACH bank transfer from your account with no transaction fee. All you need is your routing and account numbers of the account you wish to make the donation from.

Where can I see my total donations to date?

You can view a history of your online donations by logging into your donor account. If you do not already have an account, click 'Claim My Account' to set one up. Once you're logged in, click 'Donations' on the top menu bar. You will see a list of donations made in the current calendar year. To view donations made in previous years, select 'View Year End Statements' and 'View details' next to the year you wish to review. For a record of your cash or check donations, please contact TJ Heying at theying@unification.org.

Can I make recurring payments or do I need to make my donation in one payment?

You can make recurring payments by selecting 'Make My Donation Monthly Recurring' on the donation form.

Can I donate using crypto currency?

Can I make a donation by check?
