

FFWPU Cameroon's 21-day ChamBuMoRon workshop in Yaoundé

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A 21-day ChamBuMoRon workshop was held from July 14 to August 3, 2025, at the National Training Center in Yaoundé. The event brought together youth from various regions of Cameroon as well as from Chad, creating a vibrant and diverse community of participants.

Throughout the workshop, attendees received in-depth education on the Divine Principle (DP), internal guidance, and Unification Thought.
