Hiromi Kitchens was born February 29, 1956 in Hokkaido, Japan and lived there until she was 2 years old. She then moved to Miyazaki, the area where her family was from. She was athletically active as a young girl and would enthusiastically play until dark. She started piano lessons in kindergarten and was interested in art as well. She studied music in college in Okayama, Japan. It was there that she met the Unification movement in 1975. Hiromi graduated from University in 1978. She ultimately used her musical training and was teaching piano students in her Ossining home.

Hiromi received the Blessing on October 14, 1982

in Seoul, Korea with Robert Kitchens. She arrived in America in September 1983. Hiromi worked with Gary Fleisher's IOWC #team 54 in Los Angeles, toured the Western United States until she settled in

Wisconsin and worked with ministers during the Interdenominational Conference for Clergy (ICC) days, then served as a bookkeeper in Iowa until 1987. She then went to San Diego, CA and worked in a Japanese restaurant for two years before joining her husband in Ossining, NY in 1989.
