"It is with deep regret that we announce the passing of Ryan Sunghee Parrish, 22, son of James and Joanne Parrish and the brother of Kyle Parrish," according to a statement from Ryan's parents. Ryan was born on September 19, 1991 in Leesburg, Virginia and passed into the spiritual world on Thursday, April 17, 2014. He graduated from New Hope Academy in 2010.
